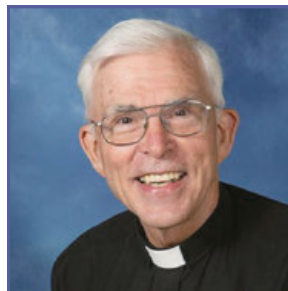

# Pastor's Letter

Dear Parishioners,

We had a blessed Divine Mercy celebration within our Pope Saint John XXIII Parish. We thank the core team members who organized this event for us. We thank you for engaging with the Novena prayers and the celebration on the Second Sunday of Easter. I also had a blessed Third Easter Sunday celebration with the Sacrament of Baptism and other events that we had within our parish's location. We gathered as a Parish Family to celebrate the Funerals for our long-time parishioners who had passed away. We comforted their families who are mourning for them. We gathered to pray the Rosary and the parish's Outreach Ministry came to visit and assist these families to celebrate the lives of their loved ones with us. We welcomed our Eucharistic Youth Organization back for their activity and we thank you for registering your children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren into this program at our parish. We have a new leadership team for our Parish Youth Group, and we had a commissioning celebration (sending out) and blessed upon them for their leadership. We thank you for attending this ceremony to bless upon them. The purpose of this ministry is to assist the children, teenagers, and young people to fall in love with the Sacrament of the Eucharist and develop a good relationship with the true present of this sacrament. I am asking you for your help, when you are sitting next to these students at Mass, could you please be a good example to them as a pious and good Faithful Catholic, so they can learn from you! They need a good example from us as well as their parents and it is the best way that we can assist them to learn and nurture their Faith.

You have been invited to attend the Anniversary Mass on the day of dedication of Saint Rita's Church and her feast day. We thank you for taking the time to join us and we thank the core team members who organized this celebration. May the Lord continue to bless upon you! We also thank those parents who shared with us the joy of new life by registering their newborn into the parish and joining us to celebrate the Sacrament of Baptism of their child with us! I thank Deacon Theman who assisted us to work with parents in preparing them for this sacrament. It is always a joy for me to baptize babies at Weekend and Weekday Masses with the Parish Family. We congratulate all the babies who received the Sacrament of Baptism during this Easter Season.

We have been experiencing cold weather during this long wintertime. We have the old facilities and many buildings that we have been using that need a lot of maintenance to serve us well. We have been faithfully maintaining and using the heating system in the Church, Religious Education buildings, Parish Office and other buildings for meetings and various ministry activities. We are using the gas heating system and it ran out of gas and the building got a little cold until we called the gas company to fill it up and another time the heating system had some problems, which required some parts to be replaced. So, we must keep up with maintenance and update different parts of the heating system and other things to keep our property and facilities in good shape to serve us. There are a lot of expenses that we must pay in keeping our buildings and facilities updated. I ask you when you are using our buildings, please try to be gentle and take care of them. Please turn off the lights, the heat, close the doors and windows before you leave the building and if you are the last person, could you please check to make sure everything that needs to be turned off is turned off!
