Pastor's Letter

Dear Parishioners,

I also spent time meeting with students and their parents for an interview for their First Holy Communion and Confirmation. Candidates for Confirmation will receive this Sacrament from Archbishop Paul Etienne on May 10th at Pope Saint John XXIII Parish, 6PM. 
