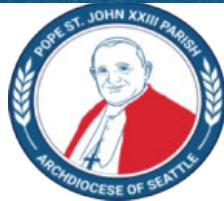

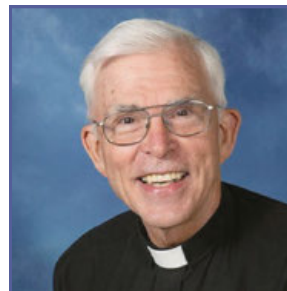

# Pastor's Letter

Dear Parishioners,

We had a blessed month of April to celebrate the Easter Season with many different events at our Pope Saint John XXIII Parish. We celebrated the Anniversary of the Dedication of Saint Rita's Church. We celebrated First Reconciliation with students from our Parish Family at different locations and sites, and we will celebrate with them their First Holy Communion within the next few weeks. We had a prayerful procession and celebration on the Feast Day of Saint Joseph the Worker, and we also honored the Virgin Mary during the month of May! 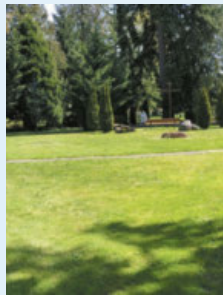

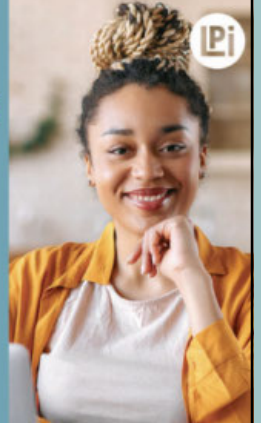
