Dear Parishioners,

We also thank you for attending the Ordination of Max to Transition Deacon at Holy Spirit Church in Kent. We also thank you for praying for the Vocation of Priesthood and Religious Life. We had two Newly Ordained Priests on June 3rd at Saint James' Cathedral. We are very blessed to have two Newly Ordained Priests for our Archdiocese of Seattle for this year. 
