

Recently, the Parish Staff, Leadership Team, and Parishioners met after Weekend Masses to better understand our Parish Family. Thanks to our Facilitators, Staff, and Leadership Team for their hard work.

Our appreciation also goes out to the Facility and Maintenance Committee for their diligent inspection of the roofs of the buildings at Pope Saint John XXIII's main campus. They dedicated their time to clearing leaves and debris from roofs, gutters, and rain pipes while sealing cracks. We are thankful for this proactive preparation before the rainy season arrived. It was astonishing to see the amount of debris and leaves accumulated on the roofs.

We celebrate couples choosing the Sacrament of Matrimony at Pope Saint John XXIII Church. They exchanged vows with loved ones, and we warmly welcome those who traveled far to join their joyous reception.

Our heartfelt thanks also go to the volunteers who promptly attended to a leak at the Parish Pastoral Center and the Church. We appreciate your use of our parish facilities for your activities and meetings. We kindly request that you remember to turn off the heat and lights when concluding your meetings, close all windows and doors, and lock the building upon departure. Ensuring all gates are closed is essential, as it discourages unauthorized activities in the parking lot. We lack full-time staff for continuous clean-up, so we rely on your support to maintain our classrooms and buildings as inviting spaces. Please treat our parish facilities as you would your own home, fostering an environment for all members of our Parish Family to utilize for various activities and events in the years ahead.

I visited Faith Formation groups on various days and noticed increased enrollment this year, with new members continuously joining. We're also happy to welcome babies and children who recently received the Sacrament of Baptism. We appreciate their parents' dedication despite busy lives. As these children prepare for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion, we're committed to supporting both them and their parents. Thanks to our core team members for their assistance.

Thanks for participating in our recent listening sessions and sharing your valuable thoughts, which provide us with important feedback. We'll share this feedback with the Archdiocese of Seattle's Partners in the Gospel Office for analysis and results.

As winter approaches, consider getting a flu shot to stay healthy. If you're unwell, please stay home and contact our Outreach Minister; we're happy to visit and bring communion. We also appreciate our dedicated Liturgical Ministers and look forward to welcoming more volunteers at other parish locations.

I had a productive meeting with long-time Saint Rita Church parishioners to discuss building concerns. We need funds for essential projects, including window repairs. Since the church's closure, we rely on Funeral Masses and Saturday prayer group meetings. Adequate financial support is crucial for maintenance, and I thank the core team for their help in finding solutions.

We appreciate your support for the Pope Saint John XXIII Statue project. Father Trung, the statue's designer, will provide more details. Join us on October 15th at 9:45 AM Mass to celebrate his Feast Day. Thank you for your ongoing support of our parish's mission and ministry.
