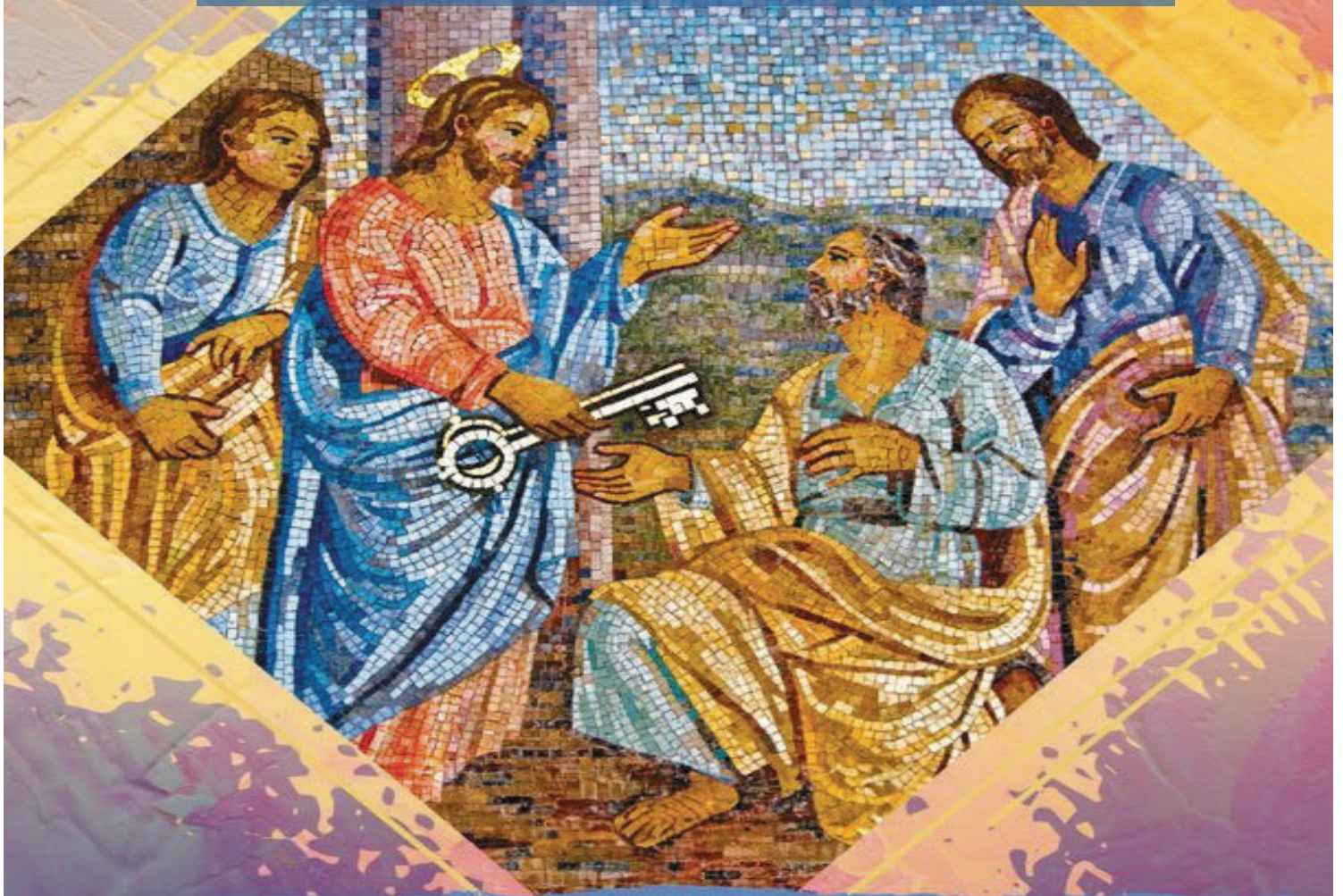

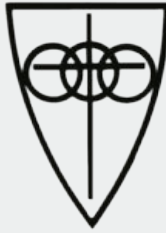

Gospel Meditation / Meditación Evangélico

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

The famous Russian novelist Fyodor Dostoyevsky said, “Love in action is a harsh and dreadful thing.” In the Gospel reading this week, Jesus does something harsh and dreadful — he watches his own disciples abandon him. What could possibly be loving about that?

Well, we notice the context is Jesus’ teaching about eating and drinking his body and blood. His followers hear this and say, “This teaching is difficult; who can accept it?” (John 6:60). We shouldn’t imagine we’d do anything different, because not even the ones who stay, like Peter, seem to understand what Jesus is saying. Then we hear this devastating line, “Because of this many of his disciples turned back and no longer went about with him” (John 6:66). Besides the night of the Last Supper, only now do Jesus’ disciples abandon him. And, painfully, Jesus just lets them go. The best way to make sense out of this is love. Jesus is God’s love in action. He wants to become one with those whom He loves. He wants to love them as His own body. Yes, the oneness manifested in the Eucharist sounds harsh and dreadful because it is rooted in love which is willing to risk abandonment and separation to attain its goal: to be one body with the beloved. It is both terrifying and wonderful that Jesus will risk losing us in order to be one with us. Our response? Lord, we cannot grasp a love so great, but please help us never to abandon it, either.

Alentar Entendimiento más profundo de la Escritura

Algunos de los seguidores de Jesús no pudieron creer lo que les dijo. Era demasiado para ellos: “*Mi carne es verdadera comida y mi sangre es verdadera bebida*” (Juan 6:55). A pesar de que Jesús lo explicaba de muchas maneras, algunos decidieron abandonarlo. Él no hizo nada por detenerlos, los dejó libres respetando su decisión. Después de esos acontecimientos de abandono, Jesús pregunta directamente a los doce: “*¿Quieren marcharse también ustedes? Pedro le contestó: Señor, ¿a quién iríamos? Tú tienes palabras de vida eterna. Nosotros creemos y sabemos que tú eres el Santo de Dios*” (Juan 6:67-69). Ahora, en la realidad que vivimos tan llena de ruido y modernidad, ¿sabemos a dónde vamos, a quién dirigimos? Pedro, lo supo y el deseo de la Iglesia es que sepamos que solo Jesús tiene palabras de vida eterna. Y que su Pan de Vida se nos da gratuitamente en la Eucaristía.

“*La Eucaristía y la cruz son piedras de tropiezo. Es el mismo misterio, y no cesa de ser ocasión de división. ¿Quieren marcharse también ustedes? (Juan 6:67): esta pregunta del Señor resuena a través de las edades, como invitación de su amor a descubrir que sólo Él tiene palabras de vida eterna (Juan 6:68), y que acoger en la fe el don de su Eucaristía es acogerlo a Él mismo*”. (Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, numeral 1335). Hagamos la prueba y veremos qué bueno es el Señor, como nos dice el Salmo de la liturgia de este domingo.

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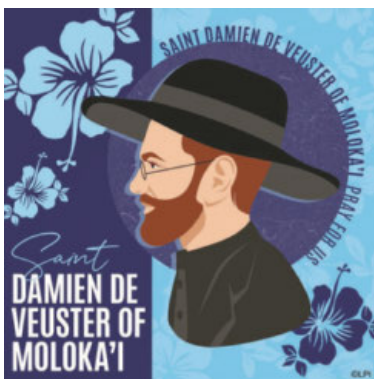
Saint of the Week / Santa de la semana

St. Damien de Veuster of Moloka’i | Feast Day: May 10th

People may be familiar with leprosy from Biblical times, but not so much in the 1800s. However, St. Damien de Veuster of Moloka’i (January 3, 1840 – April 15, 1889) would eventually shed a light on the effects of the devastating disease (leprosy) and allow people to see those afflicted with it with more compassion and love.

In 1873, he visited the Hawaiian government’s leper colony on the island of Moloka’i, where he petitioned to stay permanently to care for their physical, medical, and spiritual needs. After years of working to improve their location and those who lived there, he contracted Hansen’s disease and died of its complications. He found strength to endure isolation and disease in Eucharistic adoration and the celebration of the Mass. St. Damien was canonized by Pope Benedict XVI on October 11, 2009. St. Damien de Veuster of Moloka’i, pray for us!

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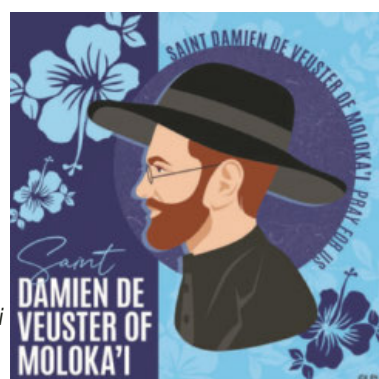


San Damien de Veuster de Moloka’i | Día Festivo: 10 de mayo

La gente probablemente está familiarizada con la lepra de los tiempos bíblicos, pero no en la década de 1800. Sin embargo, San Damien de Veuster, de Moloka’i (3 de enero de 1840 – 15 de abril de 1889), finalmente arrojaría luz sobre los efectos de esta enfermedad devastadora (leproso) y permitiría a las personas ver a los afectados con más compasión y amor.

En 1873, visitó la colonia de leproso del gobierno hawaiano en la isla de Moloka’i, donde solicitó quedarse permanentemente para atender sus necesidades físicas, médicas y espirituales. Después de años de trabajo para mejorar su ubicación y los que vivían allí, contrajo la enfermedad de Hansen y murió de sus complicaciones. Encontró fuerza para soportar el aislamiento y la enfermedad en la adoración eucarística y la celebración de la Misa. Damián fue canonizado por el Papa Benedicto XVI el 11 de octubre de 2009. St. Damien de Veuster de Moloka’i, ¡rueda por nosotros!

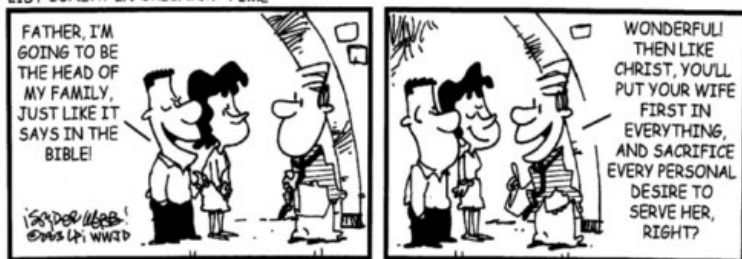

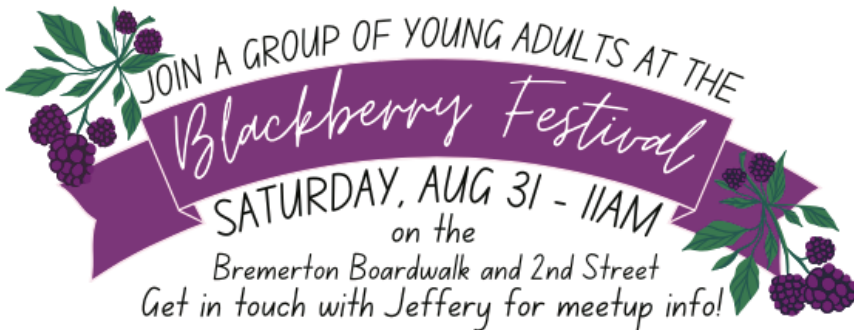

Are you interested in Volunteering?

Do you enjoy volunteering around the parish campus? Do you work with minors, vulnerable adults or handle money? Please make sure that your Safe Environments background check and training are up to date.

Definitions per the Archdiocese of Seattle:

Minors: individuals under the age of 18

Vulnerable adults: Any person over 60 unable to care for themselves; certain individuals with developmental disabilities; anyone over the age of 18 who has a legal guardian; individuals receiving in home care through a licensed health, hospice or home health care agency or from an aide hired on their own; individuals incarcerated in a correctional facility; certain individuals receiving pastoral care services.

Background checks need to be completed every 3 years per current Archdiocesan guidelines. Once you have completed your initial 3-hour live training, training updates can be completed online and are also due every 3 years.

For a first time user, go to www.virtusonline.org and click on "First-Time Registrant". If you have an account and want to see if you are up to date on your requirements enter your user name and password. If you need your credentials emailed to you, please email Sarah McLellan at sarah@holylt.org.

Mayordomía Reflexione

"Y si no les parece bien servir al Señor, escojan hoy a quién han de servir... Por mi parte mi familia y yo, serviremos al Señor." JOSUÉ 24,15

Lo siguiente son algunas definiciones según la Arquidiócesis de Seattle:

Menores: personas menores de 18 años

Adultos vulnerables: Cualquier persona mayor de 60 años incapaz de valerse por sí misma; ciertas personas con discapacidades de desarrollo; cualquier persona mayor de 18 años que tenga tutor legal; personas que reciben atención domiciliaria a través de una agencia autorizada de atención médica, de cuidados paliativos o de atención médica domiciliaria o de un asistente contratado por su cuenta; personas encarceladas en un centro correccional; ciertas personas que reciben servicios de atención pastoral.

Las verificaciones de antecedentes deben realizarse cada 3 años según las pautas actuales de la Arquidiócesis. Una vez que hayas completado tu capacitación inicial en vivo de 3 horas, las actualizaciones de capacitación se pueden completar en línea y también deben realizarse cada 3 años.

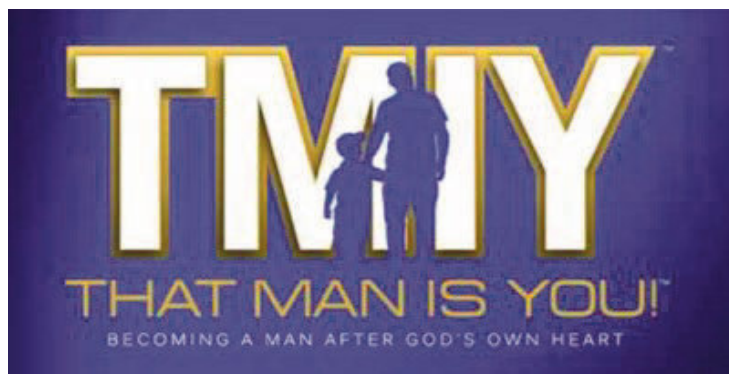

Looking for Tribunal Advocates

We are looking to grow the ranks of Tribunal Advocates here at Holy Trinity. What is an Advocate? An Advocate is first and foremost a representative of the church, ministering to people who need the assistance of the tribunal to clarify their marital status. The Tribunal is always available to the Advocate for training, support and as a resource during all cases.

Qualifications and education requirements

A Parish Tribunal Advocate must be an adult who is a Catholic in good standing. In the Archdiocese of Seattle, the position requires (1) recommendation of his/her pastor, (2) attendance at two three-day workshops led by the tribunal, (3) appointment by the tribunal (4) completion of the Oath of Office and Confidentiality, and for continued service (5) attendance at update workshops once every three years.

Preferred skills

- compassion, intelligence, and integrity
- organization (capacity to fulfill the procedural functions of the role)
- ability to keep matters confidential
- communication and listening skills
- computer literacy/ability
- the ability to speak and write in Spanish, Korean, Vietnamese or other language is always an added benefit in many of the tribunal's cases but is not required

The first of two required sessions is scheduled for September 10-12 at the Palisades in Federal Way. The deadline to register is August 24th.
