## From the President of Catholic Schools

March 21, 2021 Fifth Sunday of Lent



“I have been crucified with Christ,” St. Paul tells us, “and it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God who loved me and gave himself for me” (Gal. 2:18b-20).

These words allude to the fact that all of us who have been baptized are no longer living a merely natural life but a *supernatural* life in Jesus Christ. It is a good thing too, because our natural powers are not strong enough to complete the mission at hand. We literally need superpowers, the superpowers of God.

Two weeks ago, I showed the image *Victory, O Lord*, an image of Moses holding his hands up, supported by Aaron and Hur, as God defeated the Amalekites in the battle below. Last week, I talked about how important community is in living out the Gospel. Moses needed Aaron and Hur supporting his arms so that he could keep them raised. But if it hadn't been for the superpowers of God working in Moses, Moses having his arms up would have made precisely zero contributions to the battle.

Generally, the way that God works in our lives is far less obvious than what we see in this image. Though it be less obvious, it is no less present. God has commanded you, has commanded me, to love one another as he has loved us, to love our enemy, to forgive not seven times but seventy-seven times, to pick up our cross daily and follow him. Ultimately, all of

these commandments are impossible for us to live out by our own strength. So why does he

command it, because we need to learn to have God's strength living and working in us. If we don't we will not be strong enough to withstand being in God's presence in heaven. St. John tells us that in heaven, “we will be like [God], for we shall see Him as He is” (1 Jn 3:2). God begins in this world making us like Him, so that we can be with Him in heaven.

At times, the work feels overwhelming, the path too steep, the weight too heavy to bear. These experiences are an important reminder of our need to be close to God. Through prayer, especially prayer before the blessed sacrament, and receiving Christ in the sacraments of the Eucharist and reconciliation, God fills us with His supernatural power. This Lent, I invite you to grow in your devotional life. Pray more, pray better, be filled with God's grace that it may truly be no longer you that lives, but Christ that lives in you. Through this you will conquer the world.

P.S. We do not often know how these prayers impact our work. Every week both Assumption and DeSales Catholic Schools have school Mass. Every day begins with each school praying together as a whole and reflecting on the day's Gospel. Every class period begins with a moment of prayer. I do not know how exactly God uses these prayers to change the life of the school, but I know that God is working through it.







**“He sido crucificado con Cristo,” nos dice San Pablo, “y ya no soy yo quien vive, sino que es Cristo que vive en mi. Y la vida que vivo ahora en la carne la vivo por fe en el Hijo de Dios que me amó y se dió así mismo por mí” (Gal. 2: 18b– 20). Estas palabras**

**aluden al hecho de que todos los que hemos sido bautizados ya no vivimos una vida meramente natural, sino una vida sobrenatural en Jesucristo. También es algo Bueno, porque nuestros poderes naturales no son lo suficientemente Fuertes para completar la misión en cuestión. Literalmente necesitamos superpoderes, los superpoderes de Dios.**

**Hace dos semanas, enseñé una imagen “Victoria, O Señor”, una imagen de Moisés con sus manos hacia arriba, apoyado por Aarón y Hur, mientras Dios derrotó a los Amalecitas en la batalla. La semana pasada, hablé acerca de lo importante que es la comunidad para vivir el Evangelio. Moisés necesitaba a Aaron y Hur para que apoyaran sus brazos para mantenerlos levantados. Pero si no hubiera sido por los superpoderes de Dios trabajando en Moisés, Moisés con los brazos en alto no habría hecho ninguna contribución a la batalla.**

**Generalmente, la forma en que Dios trabaja en nuestras vidas es mucho menos obvia de lo que vemos en esta imagen. Aunque sea menos obvio, no está menos presente. Dios te ha mandado a ti, me ha mandado a mí, que nos amemos unos a otros como Él nos ha amado, amar a nuestro enemigo, perdonar no solo siete veces sino setenta veces siete, de llevar nuestra cruz diariamente y seguirlo.**

**En última instancia, todos estos mandamientos son**

**imposibles de cumplir por nuestras propias fuerzas. Entonces porque lo ordena, porque necesitamos aprender a tener la fuerza de Dios**

**viviendo y trabajando en nosotros. Si no lo hacemos no seremos lo suficientemente fuertes para soportar estar en la presencia de Dios en el cielo. San Juan nos dice que en el cielo, “seremos como {Dios}, porque lo veremos tal cual es” (1 Jn. 3:2) Dios comienza en esta tierra haciéndonos semejantes a Él, para que podamos estar en el cielo con Él.**

**Algunas veces, el trabajo se siente agotador, el camino demasiado empinado, la carga muy pesada para soportar. Estas experiencias son un importante recordatorio de nuestra necesidad de estar cerca de Dios. Por medio de la oración, especialmente oración ante el Santísimo Sacramento, y recibiendo a Cristo en el sacramento de la Eucaristía y Reconciliación. Dios nos llena con su poder sobrenatural. Esta Cuaresma, los invito a crecer en su vida devocional. Orar más y mejor, ser llenados con la gracia de Dios que verdaderamente ya no seas tú quien viva, sino que Cristo viva en ti. Por medio de esto conquistarás el mundo.**
