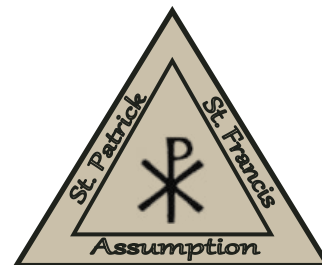

From the Pastor

January 16, 2022



Last week we ended on a bit of a downer. We realized that the question as to whether the Church has the right to make decisions in the areas of faith and morals and the

manner in which she makes such decisions is, for some, a moot point. This is because, for a certain group of people, they have already denied that right to God Himself.

This, of course, is terribly tragic. It is tragic, not because it leaves one locked in a pattern of making bad or sinful decisions, nor because it results in one failing to do the tremendous good to which he or she may be called. No, it is tragic because it reveals that one does not, fundamentally, believe that God loves His children. One does not trust that our Lord loves each of us with a passionate, unchanging love.

Any parent knows that, at times they must ask their little ones to do things that are difficult. Additionally, they realize that their children may not understand the reason why. However, as adults, we know that there are certain things that parents can't tell their children or, even if they want to explain, their children are still too young to fully understand—for example, when very young children need difficult health treatment due to serious illness. However, we know that, though it is difficult, maybe even painful, that which parents ask their children to

do is motivated by unconditional love and a desire to see their little ones flourish. If this is true of parents, then it is all the more so with God. “If you then, who are wicked, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give good things to those who ask him” (Matthew 7:11).

So why, then, do some people not trust in God's love and goodness? Certainly, we can see reasons for this in broken homes, abusive parental relationships, authority figures breaking confidence and the like. However, this doubting of God's goodness goes all the way back to the garden of Eden.

Next week we will continue this reflection on consider how we can overcome a lack of confidence in God's love for us.

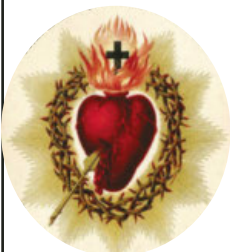

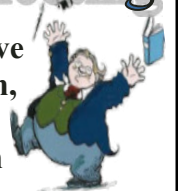

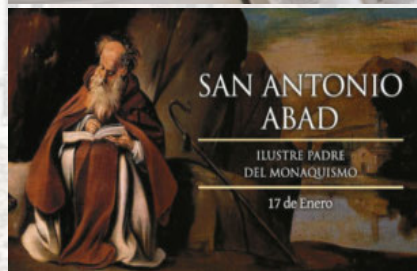

CARTA DEL PARROCO
JANUARY 16TH 2022



La semana pasada terminamos un poco deprimentes. Nos dimos cuenta de que la cuestión de si la Iglesia tiene derecho a tomar decisiones en las áreas de fe y moral y la manera

en que toma tales decisiones es, para algunos, un punto discutible. Esto se debe a que, para cierto grupo de personas, ya le han negado ese derecho a Dios mismo.

Esto, por supuesto, es terriblemente trágico. Es trágico, no porque lo deje a uno encerrado en un patrón de tomar decisiones malas o pecaminosas, ni porque resulte en que uno no haga el tremendo bien al que puede ser llamado. No, es trágico porque revela que uno, fundamentalmente, no cree que Dios ama a sus hijos. Uno no confía en que nuestro Señor nos ama a cada uno de nosotros con un amor apasionado e inmutable.

Cualquier padre sabe que, en ocasiones, deben pedirle a sus niños que hagan cosas que son difíciles. Además, se dan cuenta de que es posible que sus hijos no comprendan la razón. Sin embargo, como adultos, sabemos que hay ciertas cosas que los padres no pueden decirles a sus hijos o, incluso si quieren explicarles, sus hijos aún son demasiado pequeños para entender completamente, por ejemplo, cuando los niños muy pequeños necesitan un tratamiento médico difícil debido a una enfermedad grave. Sin embargo, sabemos que, aunque es difícil, tal vez

incluso doloroso, lo que los padres piden a sus hijos está motivado por el amor incondicional y el deseo de ver florecer a los pequeños.

Si esto es cierto en el caso de los padres, entonces lo es aún más para en el caso de Dios. “Si ustedes, que son malos, saben dar cosas buenas a sus hijos, ¡cuánto más el Padre celestial dará cosas buenas a aquellos que se las pidan!” (Mateo 7:11)

Entonces, ¿por qué algunas personas no confían en el amor y la bondad de Dios? Ciertamente, podemos ver las razones de esto en hogares rotos, relaciones paternas abusivas, figuras de autoridad que rompen la confianza y cosas por el estilo. Sin embargo, esta duda de la bondad de Dios se remonta al jardín del Edén.

La próxima semana continuaremos con esta reflexión sobre cómo podemos superar la falta de confianza en el amor de Dios por nosotros.

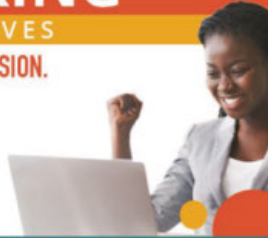
