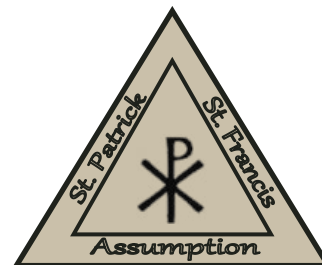

From the Pastor
January 23, 2022



Last week we reflected on how a lack of trust in God's love leads some to be closed to any difficult teaching that might require them to make significant or painful decisions in life. We even noted

some reasons why individuals might struggle to trust in God's love for them—broken homes, abusive parents, authority figures breaking confidence, etc.

However, I noted that this problem, failing to trust in God's love, is not new nor reserved to those who have experienced trauma or betrayal in their past. It goes all the way back to the garden of Eden.

When He created the garden, God had made the entire visible creation to bless Adam and Eve and to manifest His love to them. However, Satan suggested to our first parents that there was one, very good thing, that God was withholding from Adam and Eve—the fruit granting the knowledge of good and evil. In effect, the enemy whispered into their ears: “Why would a loving God withhold such a tremendous good from those he claims to love? Perhaps, he doesn't really love you? Maybe it would be best if you didn't trust Him entirely and looked after yourselves a bit—then you, too, will be like Him, gods.” And, this is exactly what they did. They chose to doubt God's goodness and love for them, turned their backs on Him, reached out to take their own ruin in hand, and partook of their own condemnation.

If Adam and Eve managed to doubt the goodness of God, even without the traumatizing contexts of

our fallen world, broken families, and the like, how are we to overcome such pernicious doubts?

Here, too, God provides us a way. Since the gift of the entirety of visible creation was not enough to reveal the Father's heart to mankind and win our hearts, he would take it a step further. Even after we had rebelled, walked away from Him, and condemned ourselves to perdition, God chose to chase after us and free us from our condemnation. However, He didn't do so by a simple act of power or divine command. He did it through His birth in time, His life amongst us, and, above all, by His death upon the cross.

If we desire to grow in our trust in God's love, then we need look no further than the cross. Christ did not need to die on the cross to win our salvation—as God, He could have chosen to save us in any way He pleased. He chose the cross so that, as we gazed upon His body, broken, beaten, and torn—we would never be able to doubt the depths of His love for us. Therefore, meditate upon the cross daily and daily your confidence in God's unconditional love for you will grow.

This practice, meditating upon the cross of Christ, can be accomplished in various ways—through the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary, the 15 prayers of St. Bridget, or even simply sitting before a crucifix and contemplating the unstinting goodness of God.

Praised be Jesus Christ, now and forever!

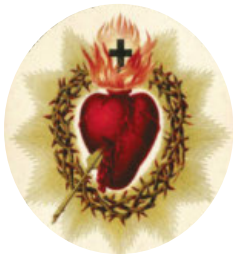

CARTA DEL PARROCO
JANUARY 23, 2022



La semana pasada reflexionamos sobre cómo la falta de confianza en el amor de Dios lleva a algunos a cerrarse a cualquier enseñanza difícil que pueda requerir que tomen decisiones significativas o

dolorosas en la vida. Incluso notamos algunas razones por las que las personas pueden tener dificultades para confiar en el amor de Dios por ellas: hogares destrozados, padres abusivos, figuras de autoridad que rompen la confianza, etc.

Sin embargo, noté que este problema, la falta de confianza en el amor de Dios, no es nuevo ni está reservado a quienes han experimentado traumas o traiciones en el pasado. Va todo el camino de regreso al jardín de Edén.

Cuando creó el jardín, Dios había hecho toda la creación visible para bendecir a Adán y Eva y manifestarles su amor. Sin embargo, Satanás sugirió a nuestros primeros padres que había una cosa muy buena que Dios les estaba negando a Adán y Eva: el fruto que otorgaba el conocimiento del bien y del mal. En efecto, el enemigo les susurró al oído: “¿Por qué un Dios amoroso negaría un bien tan tremendo a quienes dice amar? Tal vez, él realmente no te ama? Tal vez sería mejor si no confiaran en Él por completo y se cuidaran un poco, entonces ustedes también serán como Él, dioses”. Y, esto es exactamente lo que hicieron. Eligieron dudar de la bondad y el amor de Dios por ellos, le dieron la espalda, se acercaron para tomar su propia ruina en sus manos y participaron de su propia condenación.

Si Adán y Eva lograron dudar de la bondad de Dios, incluso sin los contextos traumáticos de

nuestro mundo caído, familias rotas y similares, ¿cómo vamos a superar esas dudas perniciosas?

Aquí, también, Dios nos proporciona un camino. Dado que el don de la totalidad de la creación visible no fue suficiente para revelar el corazón del Padre a la humanidad y conquistar nuestros corazones, él daría un paso más. Incluso después de que nos rebelamos, nos alejamos de Él y nos condenamos a la perdición, Dios eligió perseguirnos y liberarnos de nuestra condenación. Sin embargo, no lo hizo por un simple acto de poder o mandato divino. Lo hizo por su nacimiento en el tiempo, su vida entre nosotros y, sobre todo, por su muerte en la cruz.

Si deseamos crecer en nuestra confianza en el amor de Dios, entonces no necesitamos mirar más allá de la cruz. Cristo no necesitó morir en la cruz para ganar nuestra salvación; como Dios, Él podría haber elegido salvarnos de la manera que quisiera. Eligió la cruz para que, al contemplar su cuerpo, roto, golpeado y desgarrado, nunca pudiéramos dudar de la profundidad de su amor por nosotros. Por lo tanto, medite en la cruz diariamente y diariamente crecerá su confianza en el amor incondicional de Dios por usted.

Esta práctica de meditar en la cruz de Cristo, se puede lograr de varias maneras: a través de los Misterios Dolorosos del Rosario, las 15 oraciones de Santa Brígida, o incluso simplemente sentándose ante un crucifijo y contemplando la bondad inagotable de Dios.

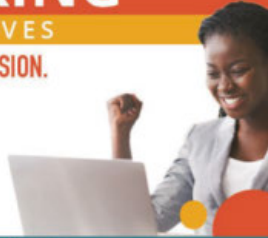
