Sunday November 8, 2020 - 32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

GOSPEL READING: Matthew 25:1-13

1 "Then the kingdom of heaven shall be compared to ten maidens who took their lamps and went to meet the bridegroom. 2 Five of them were foolish, and five were wise. 3 For when the foolish took their lamps, they took no oil with them; 4 but the wise took flasks of oil with their lamps. 5 As the bridegroom was delayed, they all slumbered and slept. 6 But at midnight there was a cry, 'Behold, the bridegroom! Come out to meet him.' 7 Then all those maidens rose and trimmed their lamps. 8 And the foolish said to the wise, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.' 9 But the wise replied, 'Perhaps there will not be enough for us and for you; go rather to the dealers and buy for yourselves.' 10 And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the marriage feast; and the door was shut. 11 Afterward the other maidens came also, saying, 'Lord, lord, open to us.' 12 But he replied, 'Truly, I say to you, I do not know you.' 13 Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour."

Meditation:

Are you missing out on what is most important in life? Being unprepared can lead to unnecessary trouble and even disaster! What good is a lifejacket left on the shore when the boat is sinking? Jesus' story of ten single ladies waiting for a wedding procession in the middle of the night seems strange to most westerners today. But Jesus' audience knew all too well how easily this could happen to them.

Lord Jesus, make me vigilant and attentive to your voice that I may always heed your call. May I find joy in your presence and delight in doing your will

Providing Warmth to Neighbors in Need

Interfaith Coalition’s annual winter warmth drive provides coats each year for everyone from babies to seniors. The

procedure for donating coats, jackets, scarves, gloves, etc, has changed significantly this year due to Covid-19 concerns. Donated items should be clean, gently used, laundered if possible, or new. Please place the items into a plastic bag that is labeled on the outside of the bag with the number of coats, sizes, gender (if applicable) and twist-tie the bag shut. We cannot accept any unbagged items. Please contact Mary Pardue at 360-306-0057 to arrange for pick-up. Mary will drop off the items at the United Church of Ferndale prior to distribution in late October of early December. There will be no drop off boxes at St. Joseph Church this year. For many of our neighbors, this program means they won’t need to spend limited income on a winter coat or do without. Thank you for your continued generosity as a parish.

Guide to indoor Mass

Safety:

We have eliminated the Sign of Peace and the reception from the chalice.

Offertory:

Please drop your offering in the basket on the way in.

Communion:

Eucharist Ministers will distribute communion during the normal time. Please sit or kneel to receive the Eucharist. Remove your mask right before the Eucharistic Minister comes to you. Communion will only be offered on an open, flat hand.

If You Feel Sick:

If you feel sick now, please leave immediately for the sake of your fellow parishioners.

At the end of Mass, please wait for your Ushers to excuse your pew.

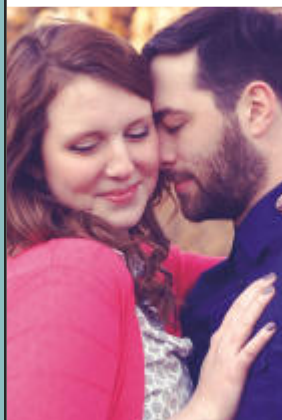
