HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH GROUP

The High School youth group will be starting up January 5, 2022 and will continue to meet weekly from 7:00pm-8:30pm. We are still meeting at the Saint Patrick Parish Office - enter through the side door, up the stairs, by the parking lot entrance. We will be collaborating as a co-ed group and ending the night in a small group to dive deeper into discussion. We will be going through a series called "The Search". In this series we will search to answer the fundamental questions of every human; who are we; why are we here; and is God real?

CONFIRMATION CLASS

Confirmation classes will continue to meet weekly Thursday nights from 6:00pm-7:30pm at Holy Cross in the parish center. We will have a Confirmation retreat on Vocations February 12, 2022 from 9am-3pm at Holy Cross. Father Justin Ryan the vocation director of the Archdiocese and Father Paul, OSB will be guest speakers for the retreat. The Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated on April 30, 2022 at the 5pm mass; the mass will take place at Saint Charles Borromeo.

NEW BIBLE STUDY COMING IN JANUARY FOR WEDNESDAY MORNINGS

Jesus: The Way, the Truth, and the Life is a new and fresh look at Jesus—who he is, what he is really like, what he taught, and what he did for our salvation. This encounter with Christ will inspire and empower you to center your entire life around him as you come to know and love him in an ever deeper and more intimate way. This is a 10 week study from Ascension Press that will meet on Wednesday mornings at 9:45 beginning January 5th. (after daily mass) We will meet in the Parish Center for now.

FAITH FORMATION

St. Charles offers several opportunities in the area of Faith Formation. Classes for children resume today, but will be VIRTUAL for our families' and catechists' safety. We are off the following Sunday for the MLK weekend and plan to resume In-Person learning on January 23. We have year round registrations and still have room in many grades. Our children's Religious Education program is both family and age level organized. It is offered on Sundays for children ages 4 (Pre-K) to 12 (6th Grade). Note: Families expecting children to participate in First Eucharist and Penance should be enrolled in Religious Ed by their First grade year if not attending a Catholic School. We also have a Catechesis of the Good Shepherd experience for children ages 3-6. We are meeting both in person and occasionally virtually. We practice social distance and children must wear masks.
