






### Infant Baptism (ages 0-6 years)

#### Families, don't book your relatives' tickets just yet!

Many parents have been scheduling their child's baptism before they have even met with me, only to be informed that the date they have chosen is not the date the baptisms have been scheduled at a Mass. Then they are disappointed. Our next Parent Baptism Preparation session will take place on Monday, September 9, 2024 from 7-8:30 pm in the parish center. Please register by 10:00 am that morning. If you are planning to have your child baptized in October, November, or December, make sure to register to attend by emailing me, Debs at dpokos@stcharlesb.org.



### **Initiation Ministry**

Our babies are now in their 7th month of development: 3<sup>rd</sup> trimester of pregnancy (28-31 weeks). They are about 14-17 inches long and weigh between 2.5-4.5 lbs. Our babies are adding weight quickly, their heads are growing to make room for their developing brains, and they are kicking and getting hiccups. Moms are feeling more fatigue and experiencing more physical and emotional stress as the due date nears.

Jesus, Mary and Joseph, I love you very much. I beg you to spare the life of the unborn baby that I have spiritually adopted who is in danger of abortion.


#### 40 DAYS FOR LIFE FALL CAMPAIGN -TACOMA VIGIL VOLUNTEERS NEEDED
