

<u>FAITH FORMATION- A Family of</u> <u>Faith:</u>



Our program is family based with some learning at home and some for both parents and children here on campus. We meet from 11:15 to 12:15 in Feist Hall on selected Sundays.



SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION

Jesus calls us all to come to Him through the sacraments in order to establish a relationship with Him. He continues to meet us in the sacraments that heal, nourish, strengthen and guide us on the path of life.

If you are a **Catholic** parent with a child in the **2nd grade** who has been baptized but **NOT yet** received the sacraments of Penance or Eucharist (First Holy Communion), you may begin the preparation process this fall **IF** you are ready to make this commitment. Families are asked to be enrolled in our Family of Faith program for a **remote year** of preparation beginning in the **first grade.** Then they move into 2nd grade, participating in **both** in our Family of Faith program and an At-Home family based Eucharist program. Jesus, Mary and Joseph, I love you very much. I beg you to spare the life of the unborn baby that I have spiritually adopted who is in danger of abortion.


40 Days for Life Fall Campaign - Tacoma Vigil Volunteers Needed




