# FAITH FORMATION- A Family of *Faith*:



### SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION FOR HOLY COMMUNION

Jesus calls us all to come to Him through the sacraments in order to establish a relationship with Him. He continues to meet us in the sacraments that heal, nourish, strengthen and guide us on the path of life.

If you are a **Catholic** parent with a child in the **2nd grade** who has been baptized but **NOT yet** received the sacraments of Penance or Eucharist (First Holy Communion), you may begin the preparation process this fall **IF** you are ready to make this commitment. 
