

SCRIP will be sold after all masses on January 11th and 12th.



Approx. 75% of the Nativity House Shelter Population is male.

PRAY AND ACT - JANUARY 22 - "DAY PRAYER FOR THE LEGAL PROTECTION OF UNBORN CHILDREN"

This day of prayer was originally declared to coincide with the anniversary of the 1973 Roe v Wade supreme court decision to legalize abortion in the U.S. It continues as a remembrance and as a reminder to pray that hearts & minds value the dignity of every human life and to encourage laws that protect unborn children, especially in WA State. Today, women in our own communities are pregnant, poor, perhaps without a home, and in great need. They may feel alone, scared, and overwhelmed, not knowing where they can turn for help.

On January 22, please plan to attend Mass or pray the rosary or make a donation of time, talent or treasure to a Pregnancy Resource Center.
