



#### Saint Vincent de Paul

Blessed Frederic Ozanam, Who, motivated by a student's challenge regarding the role of Christianity in helping the poor, founded the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, in 1832. Through the society, volunteers serve millions of disadvantaged people around the globe. SVdP provides essential services like food, housing assistance, and care for the poor. Frederic recognized and responded to the needs around him, promoting acts of generosity and service that fit each person's individual circumstances, while going on home visits and inviting prayer for guidance in sharing blessings with others.

Every month, we distribute between \$9,000 and \$11,000, and with more resources, our impact could grow even further. Each week is different in the number of individuals and families we serve.

In the last week in May we touch the lives of around 82 individuals and families. Just this past week, we had the privilege of helping a dedicated mom with four children restore their water supply, showing that together, we can make a difference.

### **Anointing of the Sick**

Contrary to belief, an anointing is not just for those who are actively dying. One can receive an anointing if they are severely ill, are about to have surgery, are actively dying or any other emergency circumstances. Although we know that it is not always possible to give ample notice for an anointing, if possible we ask to not wait until the last minute so we can ensure priests are able to make it in time.

If you are in need of an anointing please call Cathy at 253-564-5185 ext. 3011. If you are in need of an anointing for someone who is actively dying (outside office hours), please call the emergency line at 253-564-5185 and press 3.

Attending Saturday or Sunday Mass and need an anointing? No problem. Fr. Michael and Fr. Marc welcome you to be anointed after any Mass! Just stand/sit by the Baptismal font and they will meet you after Mass.

The layettes are made up with blankets, 2 outfits, sleepers, onesies, bath towels and washcloths. These items are wrapped in a beautiful baby quilt, most coming from the St Charles quilt group.

### **Gabriel Project**

Every month Gabriel Project, Guadalupe Maternity Center, Pregnancy Aid and Prepares, will alternate sharing experiences of our individual Catholic ministries in this Sunday bulletin space.

Here is a snapshot of Gabriel Project's ministry. When we are contacted about a pregnant woman who needs help, we set up a meeting to get to know her situation. We explain that we can furnish all she needs for herself and her newborn baby. On the first visit we give her a St. Charles quilt and a book, "Angel in the Waters", about the baby and his/her Guardian Angel. We offer transportation, help in applying for financial assistance, locating a doctor, education about pregnancy, stages of a baby's development after birth, and family issues.

We offer friendship and take our cues from how much the client wants us to be involved.


