## Welcome Weekend



Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini was an Italian immigrant to America. She later became an American Citizen and the first Canonized American Saint. As small girl she always showed a deep heart for serving those in need. After being rejected from a religious community of nuns because of her poor health, she founded her own order to serve the needs of those who needed it most. Pope Leo XIII called her to be a missionary in America to serve the Italian immigrants in their transition to a new life. She traveled the country founding hospitals and orphanages, many of which still stand today.

One can receive an anointing if they are severely ill, are about to have surgery, are actively dying or any other emergency circumstances. Although we know that it is not always possible to give ample notice for an anointing, if possible we ask to not wait until the last minute so we can ensure priests are able to make it in time.

If you are in need of an anointing please call Cathy at 253-564-5185 ext. 3011. If you are in need of an anointing for someone who is actively dying (outside office hours), please call the emergency line at 253-564-5185 and press 3.

Attending Saturday or Sunday Mass and need an anointing? No problem. Fr. Michael and Fr. Marc welcome you to be anointed after any Mass! Just stand/sit by the Baptismal font and they will meet you after Mass.
