

Building Project Update A message from the Pastor

Thank you, Fr. Mike,

I am so grateful to Fr. Mike for all amazing the work he has put into the construction of our parish office building. The fire that destroyed our old parish office building in 2022 forced our parish to respond and Fr. Mike led the design and fundraising process that laid the groundwork for our new office building which has been under construction since summer of 2024.

On Schedule, so far

We thank Hilger Construction and the team managing the project for keeping the project on schedule. Windows are installed, siding is going up and so is drywall. We have targeted January 2026 for the completion of construction and that target is still within reach. To keep that schedule:

- We really want to clear the temporary fencing in the parking lot (or as much of it as possible) by the time school starts. However, some of the asphalt in the parking lot needs replacement and that could require some of the construction fencing stay up for a bit longer.
- We eagerly await the arrival of the elevator needed for ADA compliance.
- · We anticipate rough-in installation of the HVAC system within a week or two.

On Budget, so far

This isn't just an office building. It includes four meeting rooms and much needed storage space. The Archdiocese of Seattle's Property and Construction office approved for the plans for the \$8.4 million project in 2024. \$6.9 million of the project cost has already been paid, including \$3.6 million covered by insurance. The remaining \$1.5 million is covered by a loan from the Archdiocese at a favorable interest rate. Our contingency has absorbed some expenses like AV equipment, security and parking lot lighting. We will continue to closely monitor expenses in the closing months of the project.

Thank you for your support





When we are contacted about a pregnant woman who needs help, we set up a meeting to get to know her situation. We explain that we can furnish all she needs for herself and her newborn baby. On the first visit we give her a St. Charles quilt and a book, "Angel in the Waters", about the baby and his/her Guardian Angel. We offer transportation, help in applying for financial assistance, locating a doctor, education about pregnancy, stages of a baby's development after birth, and family issues. We offer friendship and take our cues from how much the client wants us to be involved.

Success Story:

Molly contacted us when she was two months pregnant. She was in college and 21 years old. Her mother was forcefully pushing her for an abortion. The father of the baby was not involved. Molly was conflicted but didn't want to abort her baby. We partnered with New Beginnings as a Christian adoption agency who is very supportive and offered alternatives to an abortion. Molly decided toward the end of her pregnancy to raise her baby. Today, she is married with three children.
