New Church Safety Recommendations:

This past Tuesday, the CDC issued new recommendations for mask-wearing indoors. Because of the escalating infections due to the delta variant, they now recommend that in regions where infection rates are rising, **all wear masks** and observe social distancing in indoor venues **even those who have been fully vaccinated**.



Out of concern for all, we **strongly recommend** that our Sacred Heart parishioners return to wearing masks in church or in the social hall and be careful to maintain the 6' social distancing we have been observing throughout the pandemic.

It is clear that these more dangerous virus variants are the result of large populations around the world (and here) who have not yet been vaccinated. 
A Word from Father...



Dear Friends,

The discouragement is palpable. As our local community, our nation, and much of our world experience another wave of COVID infections, hospitalizations, and most sadly, deaths, it is just plain disheartening that we have not yet won the war against this aggressive and dangerous virus. Having to reluctantly put masks back on our faces when we are indoors after our early summer reprieve is perhaps the most tangible sign of our weariness with this virus and its variants. Ugh!

Donning masks so recently doffed is also perhaps the least difficult contribution all of us can now make to slow the spread of the much more infectious Delta variant of the virus. Delta is 1000 times more infectious than the original virus and can infect even fully vaccinated persons, like most of us; though Delta is not likely to make the vaccinated seriously ill, it can still be spread by the non-vaccinated to others. That is new knowledge we didn't have even just a few weeks ago. So the new advice from the WHO and CDC for all of us to mask up indoors has facts to back it up. *Let's do it.*



Though donning masks may be in some ways the easiest way for all of us to contribute to winning this battle once and for all, there is still another contribution that will do far more good: *for the unvaccinated to get the jab themselves.* I know there are medical reasons why the vaccines are not recommended for some, but they are few who should

not get it. I know also that some have other reasons of a personal nature to not get the vaccine, but I ask those to seriously examine if those reasons are sufficient to justify this virus continuing to circulate, harm, and even kill. Maybe they are, but I encourage anyone who has such reasons to deeply and seriously reconsider accepting the vaccine if there is any wiggle room at all in your personal or moral considerations. In particular, our Catholic Church leaders have made it clear that there is, in fact, a *moral imperative for vaccination* in most cases.

If non-vaccination is a matter of hesitations about its safety, political reasons, or just "not having gotten around to it", I strongly encourage you to set those things aside and get the shot. As we have learned over the last eight months, the vaccines are *safe and effective* and general acceptance of them is essential to finally stopping this virus in its tracks, saving many lives, and letting us all breathe freely again. The sooner all of us get vaccinated, the sooner all of us will be safe, and life can truly return to normal.


