
Blue Envelope Fund

A Word from Father...

Dear Friends,





One thing I love about our church are the

fourteen Stations of the Cross, so artistically carved into the very brick of the church walls. Some months ago, I was able to speak by phone with Maxine Martell, the daughter of the architect, Carroll Martell, and the artist who designed and executed the Stations; she told me that at the time, there was quite a bit of consternation among some in the parish because they were not "traditional" enough. I responded that nowadays, they are loved by everyone, not least by myself. The work that went into creating those carvings was extraordinary (each green brick carved individually according to the cartoon...some of which hang in our social hall...then taken to be baked...then returned and set in place...wow!), and the results are true pieces of great art.



But what I love most is watching from my position in the sanctuary as moms or dads take a squirmy little one to the back and begin showing them the stations, and not just with their eyes, but with their little hands. It is so beautiful to see those little child hands touching and tracing and feeling the ins and outs of the carvings. The story of Jesus is being told

not just with words, but with hands and bricks! The Gospel is being proclaimed to the youngest among us!

The image of John the Baptist and Jesus carved into the brick in the baptistery would be more difficult for those little hands to reach, but at least they would have the new font with its flowing waves to touch and follow with their delicate fingers!

What a debt of gratitude we owe to Maxine Martell and her father for having the artistic foresight to know that these particular pieces of art in our church would serve us so well across the years, continue to inspire us decades on, and maybe most of all, proclaim the faith to our children!




