With the days getting shorter and the dark settling in earlier, we ask that you *please use caution* when driving through our parking lot! We have many elderly parishioners who walk to




and from Mass, and it can sometimes be difficult to see them, especially as the Saturday Vigil Mass begins after sunset now. Please drive slowly— Thank You!

Happy New Year!



This weekend concludes the glorious Season of Christmas and we enter into the first week of Ordinary Time beginning on Monday.

I'm pleased to announce that we'll have First Reconciliation for our youth on Monday evening, the 10th. A special shout-out to the parents of these students who take such good care in ensuring their children are brought up in the practice of the faith. And a special thank you to Mary Cooper, their sacramental prep teacher, who instructed them in this sacrament. These students will also take sacramental prep classes so that they are ready to be confirmed and receive their first communion in the Easter Season.

While on the topic of sacraments, please take note that the Sacrament of Reconciliation, which is celebrated on Saturday evenings, is now being celebrated inside the Church in the Confessional (rather than in the parish hall). Additionally, I have been coming in at 9:30 am on Sundays so confessions are available before Sunday Mass in the Confessional.

First Friday Holy Hours have resumed after the First Friday Mass of each month. And coffee hour on Wednesday after Mass is back! It began a couple of months ago, but was changed to Tuesdays during Advent while Fr. Bob McNeese led a scripture study on Tuesdays after Mass.


