



Dear Friends in Christ,

One of the common threads between the Old Testament and the New Testament is that God backs up His word with miracles. We see this with the prophet Moses. God sent Moses to Egypt to free the Israelites from slavery. God performed many miracles through Moses. Once the Israelites were free, God continued to do miracles. God had Moses raise his staff and part the Red Sea. God had Moses strike the rock with his staff bringing forth water. There were other prophets in the Old Testament, such as Elijah and Elisha, through whom God worked miracles in order to prove to the people that they were true prophets sent by God.

It is the same in the New Testament. Jesus Himself proved that He was sent by His heavenly Father by doing miracles. He healed the sick. The lame were able to walk. The blind could see. The deaf could hear. Jesus raised the dead to life. These miracles showed that God was with Jesus. Because of this, the people should listen to what Jesus had to say.

Jesus gave this same authority to His disciples. Jesus sent out His disciples giving them authority to cast out demons, and heal the sick (Mk 6:7-13). These works of mercy and healing would draw people to them. It would also lead the people to listen closely to what the disciples had to say. One thing led to another. The miracles led to the Gospel message. It got people's attention so that they would be attentive to the message of repentance and salvation.

Why is it necessary that it happen this way? There are many false prophets. There are many people who deliver a message that is not true. Their message usually contains errors. It may lead some people astray from God and the truth. What can they show to back up their message? Oftentimes, their message may be forced on people. We can see this in our society today where there are some ideas, or new philosophies, that are forced on us. We are told that they are the truth, and that we need to believe in them. What do they have to back up their claims that they are the truth? Given enough time, the evidence usually comes back that their ideas were wrong. Instead of helping people, they actually caused considerable damage.

God always backs up His word. Sometimes it is with miracles. Sometimes, God just allows sufficient time to elapse to prove that He is correct and that His ways are true. In the end, God always proves that His word is true.

This is why God the Father sent His only Son, Jesus, into the world. Jesus is God's Word. He is God's truth in the very person of Jesus. Jesus came to show the love and mercy that His heavenly Father had for His children who were lost because of sin. This can be a tough, demanding and cruel world. God wanted His children to know that this world was not the end. He had something much better planned. He had planned a future full of hope, joy and peace.

There are miracle workers today. There are some people who have been given the gift of healing. It is usually somebody who has a close relationship with God. They live a good life and try to bring the good news of salvation in Jesus to others. This message needs to be proclaimed today as much as it did in the time of the

Apostles. God gets the attention of many people through the miraculous healings that are done through these gifted people. Once He has their attention, then the message of repentance and salvation is proclaimed once again.

Are there more miracles taking place than we notice? I believe so. Let me explain. A miracle of healing takes place at every Mass. Do you realize this? At the altar at every Mass, a miracle takes place when the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus. When we receive the Eucharist, our venial sins are forgiven and our souls are cleansed or healed. Jesus is present in the Eucharist, and when we consume the host, we receive healing. What is the prayer that we pray just before receiving communion? "Lord, I am not worthy to have you enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed." We are praying that Jesus will heal our souls.

What other miracles take place in our Church? In the sacrament of Baptism, our souls are cleansed of original sin and any other sins that we may have committed. Our souls are reconfigured and then made one with Jesus. We become a new creation. There is a miracle that takes place in the sacrament of reconciliation. A soul damaged by sin is purified and healed by Jesus when the priest prays the words of absolution over the penitent. No matter how grave the sins, no matter how severe the damage that has been done to a person's soul, Jesus purifies it and heals it. It is made like a brand new, pure, spotless soul. Do people realize that these miracles take place all the time at our churches? Yet, they do. If only more and more people would realize the grace that God wants to pour forth upon His people, our churches would be overflowing with people.

These miracles would get people's attention, which should lead to people paying attention to the message of repentance and salvation that the Church proclaims. Yet, how many people turn a deaf ear to the message of the Church? And the reason that many are deaf to the message of the Church is that they are also blind to all healing that the Church has to offer through the sacraments. Souls are being purified, healed and saved. As some Popes have described the Church, it is like a field hospital taking care of wounded souls. Yes, some mistakes have been made, and we have had some bad leaders; but the Church is still meant to be God's beacon of light leading people to the sacraments. These will always be God's miracles. God's healing balm rejuvenating souls leading them to salvation.

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavens, as he chose us in him, . . . to be holy and without blemish before him. In [Jesus] you also, who have heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and have believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, . . . to the praise of his glory." (Eph 1:3-14) "Lord, let us see your kindness and grant us your salvation." (Ps 85)



“Where can we buy enough food for them to eat” (Jn 6:5)? When we walk into an American grocery store, there is more than enough food for us to buy. How many kinds of cereal are there? What about the kind of bread – whole wheat, Keto, artisan, gluten free, and more? And milk or substitutes like almond milk or rice milk? Now, of course, all of this is based on the notion that we have enough money to purchase what we need or want. One of the shameful aspects of the American phenomenon is that we have so much food available to us and that we also waste an awful lot of it. According to the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), each day in the United States approximately one pound of **food** per person is wasted. This equates to 103 million tons (81.4 billion pounds) of food waste generated in America in 2017, or between 30-40 percent of the **food** supply. The reality of food waste in America is that we live in a country in which more than 54 million people are food insecure (18 million of which are children) according to 2020 data collected by [Feeding America](#). These numbers are up from 37 million and 11 million, respectively, in 2019, with the sharp rise in food insecurity due to the effects of the COVID-19 public health emergency and the subsequent economic downturn. So the questions arise: What can I personally do in order to personally cut down food waste in my home? How might I be able to assist those who experience food shortages in our community or the world? The answers are a matter of environmental and human justice.

#### Parkinson's Disease

Parkinson's Disease is a common disorder of the brain; certain brain cells called neurons deteriorate. The exact reason for this process is not known. These neurons produce a chemical in the brain that helps the nervous system control muscle activity.

The primary symptoms of Parkinson's include: stiffness, tremor, slowness and lack of movement, difficulty in balance and walking. Secondary symptoms may include: depression, senility, postural deformity, and difficulty speaking.

Parkinson's disease is a chronic illness. There are no specific tests for Parkinson's. Your doctor trained in nervous system conditions (neurologist) will diagnose Parkinson's based on your medical history, a review of your symptoms, and a neurological and physical examination. If the symptoms are severe enough, the doctor might use an antiparkinsonian drug as a trial to diagnosis the presence of the disease.




