

Dear Friends in Christ,

It was nice to get away for vacation and some much needed rest. Although some people may think that there were plenty of opportunities to rest during the lockdown of 2020, in reality it was a busy and stressful time. We worked hard to maintain a connection with our parishioners; doing what we could despite the restrictions. As the Dean of the South Sound Deanery, I was relaying information between the Chancery and the priests of the deanery. Much of what we experienced was unknown territory. How do we move forward when we are faced with completely unfamiliar circumstances?

It really does take a leap of faith. We have to totally surrender to God and trust that He will lead us safely through the storm. "Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff comfort me." (Ps 23:4) The future may look dark, but the light of Christ is still there to guide us. "Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light for my path." (Ps 119:105) Are we able to see that light of Christ guiding us?

Some of the Gospel readings at Mass for the last several Sundays have been from Chapter 6 of the Gospel according to John. This is the Bread of Life discourse. Jesus is teaching His disciples about the Eucharist. At one point in the discourse Jesus starts talking about His flesh being real food and His blood being real drink. Could you imagine what was going through the minds of His disciples? Jesus had many disciples who had been following Him for quite some time. They had heard Jesus' teachings over and over again. Now all of a sudden this was a new teaching. One they had never heard before. "This is a hard saying; who can accept it?" (v. 60).

Jesus was leading them into unfamiliar territory. What looked like a future filled with light and promise darkened suddenly and very quickly. Where was this going? What other surprises would come their way? This probably all seemed like unstable ground to them now.



After being with Jesus for so long, and seeing all the miracles that He had done, one might think that His disciples would expect other unexplainable things to happen. They had seen Jesus do many unbelievable things. However, this teaching about His flesh and blood was too much for some of them.

A possible stumbling block for His disciples might have been that it was against the Law of Moses to consume blood (see Lev 17:10-14). God had warned the Israelites that if anyone consumed the blood of an animal that had been sacrificed, that person would be cut off from God and the community. Another stumbling block may have been that they thought Jesus was talking about cannibalism. How can Jesus give His flesh to eat? They couldn't see beyond the surface of what Jesus was talking about.

Peter said to Jesus, "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life." (v. 68) Jesus still has the words of eternal life. There is no one else to whom we should go. Jesus continues to say to all His disciples, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (Jn 14:6) Yes, Lord, we have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God. The future may look dark and uncertain, but You will always be the light that guides our way. Lord, please calm our hearts whenever any fear or anxiety start to overtake us. Help us to grow in faith and in trust that, with You always at our side, we may walk forward bravely and with confidence.



This is the concluding Sunday in which we've been immersed in John's Bread of Life Discourse. Jesus has been explaining to people who He is in very complex theological explanations. Some of His followers are aghast at the idea of "eating His body and drinking His blood." Jesus knows that some disciples are on the fence..."Do I stay with this Teacher or leave?" This very question is a part of the lives of so many people today. John says, "This saying is hard; who can accept it?" (Jn 6:66) This is not the only saying that is hard. How about the Ten Commandments? How about the Beatitudes? How about the washing of the feet of our sisters and brothers who suffer so much in our community and around the world? The story of Jesus in the Gospels puts us on the hook. Faith is not a private venture. We celebrate our greatest prayer, the Mass, in community. The work of Jesus is in the field. It begins on our knees but it should end in the field. How do we respond to the urgings of Pope Francis when he asks his fellow religious to "smell like sheep?" That message is meant just as much for us as it is for those in religious life. In fact, if we consider ourselves faithful Catholics, then we are living a religious life...differently, of course than clergy or consecrated women. We have been given many blessings and gifts by our Lord. Heavenly Father, instill in us your Spirit so that we may carry out the works of your Son's spirit and life by creating a more just and righteous world. Amen.


