


We are looking better and ready to move forward. Tomorrow we will be talking about the Baptism of Jesus by His cousin, St. John the Baptist. This is Jesus' first step in His public ministry.

Then we will be talking about the Mass and first off Church behavior. After that we will be talking about our responses and actions to the prayers at Mass. This is a very important part of learning about our faith and how to be an active and participating member of the congregation.

Missalettes are in the pews for you to follow along or you can get an age appropriate Missal from Amazon. This should be your focus as the Mass and especially the Eucharist as it is the most important thing for us as Catholics.

Parents, you are the primary teacher of the faith for your family. They will follow your example.

Remember, all of our programs are available for enrollment with exception of Grade 3, Year 1 and Grades 4/5, Year 2. You would not be eligible for sacraments this year but you are most welcome.



We are in the process of learning about the Sacraments. Deacon Jerry will be in this week to speak about Reconciliation and the Anointing of the Sick or as it is commonly called the "Last Rites".

We will continue for the next few weeks with a video with Fr. Mike Schmidt on "Altaration". This is a very modern 4 part series on the Sacrament of the **Eucharist**.

As we start the New Year we being planning and getting ready for the next school year. Registration for the 2022-2023 school year will begin on Sun., Jan. 30th with our Catholic School Week Open House. We will be having an Open House from 9:30 AM to 11:00 AM. This is your chance to check out the school, visit the classroom, meet the teachers and ask any questions you have about St. Philomena School. St. Philomena School is a PreK through 8th grade school.

The St. Philomena PreKindergarten Program is a five day a week program and is integrated into the full school calendar. The PreKindergarten program's morning session will focus on the academic and spiritual development of the student. The morning session begins at 8:15 AM and concludes at 11:15 AM. There is a lunch/recess time available for all PreKindergarten students. The afternoon session focuses on the physical and social development of the student. This section begins at 12:05 PM and ends at 3:00 PM. A child must be 4 years of age for by August 31st for entrance into the St. Philomena School PreKindergarten Program. There are no exceptions made to this entrance date.

The St. Philomena Kindergarten Program is a full day, five day a week program and is integrated into the full school calendar. The St. Philomena Catholic School weekly schedule is Monday 8:15-2:05 PM and Tuesdays through Friday 8:15-3:05 PM. A child must be 5 years of age for by August 31st for entrance into the St. Philomena Catholic School Kindergarten Program. There are no exceptions made to this entrance date.
