# The Power of Praise

I am sure enjoying our Wednesday night Bible Study on the Acts of the Apostles. Jeff Cavins, the presenter each Wednesday, does an excellent job of providing helpful insights into the life of the early Church and how they operated with such boldness in sharing the Good News. They faced many challenges, just as we do, but through them all God provided splendidly for all of their needs.

One of the great insights that was shared during our January 19th class was the power and importance of praising the Lord even when things are challenging or difficult. The text we were studying came from the 16th chapter of the Acts of the Apostles when Paul and Silas were singing and praising God while in jail. Suddenly, there was an earthquake that shook the foundations of the jail and the doors flew open and their chains were loosened. They didn't try and escape but remained in the jail because the Holy Spirit helped them stay focused and they were led to help save the life of the jailer who was about to fall on his sword. He then asks Paul and Silas what he must do to be saved. They shared the Gospel and all of his household was baptized.

When our lives are marked by gratitude and praising God for the many blessings we have received, it furthers the light of the Gospel and draws attention to the Lord. This is especially true when we are having great difficulties. We see so many situations in the Bible and in the history of the Church where the witness of faithful and joyful Christians has led to many conversions. It such a great blessing when we are surrounded by people who are happy and grateful instead of people who complain about everything.

Music is a powerful gift that really touches the soul and I'll never forget when I was in college I discovered a Christian music club. Once a month I would get a cassette with beautiful Christian music that drew me into a place of peace and gratitude.

The Enemy always wants to remind us of what we don't have and what is lacking, broken, etc. in our lives. When we make the decision to praise the Lord (especially in difficulties) the focus shifts from ourselves to God who can and wants to do great things – even in the midst of our brokenness and struggles.

Psalm 34 verse 2 says it so beautifully, "I will bless the Lord at all times; his praise shall be always in my mouth."


