PASTOR'S CORNER

THE VISION AND MISSION OF FAITH

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me, to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord.

With these words, Jesus unveils in the gospel today his vision and mission taken from the Book of the Prophet Isaiah. As followers of Christ, they are not just his vision and mission, but ours too. Take the words of the Prophet Isaiah as your own: “The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me.” To be anointed is to be set apart or to be chosen for an important role. This role springs from our being as beloved children of God. Thus, our “anointing” does not depend on our own capacities and doing, but on the fatherhood of God. Do you believe that you are chosen and that God sees you with a unique set of eyes because He loves you as a Father?

To bring glad tidings to the poor. Our uniqueness in the eyes of God does not isolate us from one another but confers a deeper solidarity with one another especially the poor. To bring glad tidings is to be an instrument of hope. Who are the poor? All of us, without exception because there is some level of poverty in each of us. Only God is self-sufficient. What “poverty” do you experience in your life right now? To whom are you called to bring glad tidings right now so that they can be enriched?

“He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives or to let the oppressed go free.” What are those things that continue to imprison and chain us that rob us of joy and a fuller life? True freedom comes from God alone. His death and resurrection unchained us from the bonds of sin and death. His death and resurrection not only bailed us out, but paid the price of our truest freedom.

“Recovery of sight to the blind” – this means being able to see the truth, especially the truth that Christ proclaimed, lived, and passed on to the Church. Does my life mirror the teachings of the Church? Am I blinded by my own biases, conveniences, and prejudices? Do I stand for the truth of the Gospel or do I proclaim a different kind of gospel that runs contrary to my faith out of personal convenience?

The words of the Prophet of Isaiah are not empty slogans that Christ lifted from a book. They took flesh in Christ and found fulfillment in his life. Are the words of the Prophet Isaiah getting fulfilled in your hearing because they are taking flesh in your discipleship?

AROUND THE DIOCESE



Rachel's Vineyard Retreats offer healing to women and men who have been affected by abortion. The retreats offer reconciliation with God and help them to honor the lives of their lost children. A past retreatant stated "I have healed more in one weekend than in 30 years of counseling and was given tools to continue healing. Another said, "I have never felt so loved and forgiven." Another said that "she would encourage anyone who has experienced an abortion to attend the retreat."

Project Aurora collaborates with Mt. Angel in teaching seminarians about the trauma of abortion and how to respond to a person in their roles as priests after their ordination. The Archdiocese has over 40 priests who have attended a Rachel's Vineyard Retreat. One current priest who attended a retreat while in seminary said that It changed him and his priesthood.

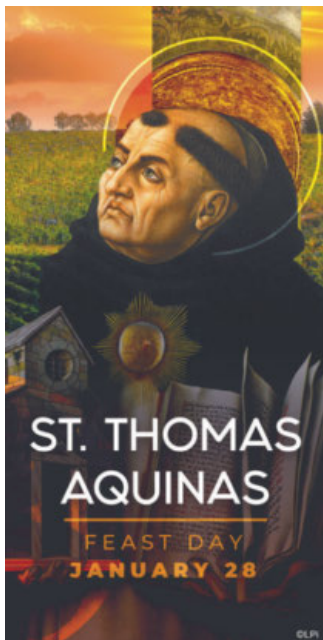

St. Thomas Aquinas | January 28

One of the most famous members of the Dominican Order, St. Thomas Aquinas (1225 – 1274) is well-known by many for his theological work, "The Summa Theologiae." Born in Italy, his mother wanted him to become a Benedictine and had high hopes that he would eventually become abbot of Monte Cassino, where he spent much of his youth. To change his vocation, she had him kidnapped by his brothers on his way to Paris at the age of 19. He spent two years in their captivity. Despite this, nothing could shake him from his vocation to become a Dominican priest and he was eventually released. Once free, he went to Paris and then to Cologne, where he finished his studies with Albert the Great.

His greatest contribution to the Catholic Church is his writings. The unity, harmony, and continuity of faith and reason, of revealed and natural human knowledge, encompasses his writings. The Summa Theologiae, his last and, unfortunately, uncompleted work, deals with the whole of Catholic theology.

The patron saint of teachers, theologians and students, St. Thomas Aquinas died in 1274. His life and the impact he had on the whole Church, however, remains alive today.

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP

Everyday Stewardship Plant Your Works in the Word

One of the things about Scripture is that even the smallest word and shortest phrase can be critical to the overall message. When you take a quiet moment to rest with the Word, you find how quickly the most mundane sentence can reach out and grab you, pulling you into a deeper contemplation of some truth you hadn't even considered until then.

But we often fail to act as the Israelites in the Book of Nehemiah, standing before the Water Gate "listening attentively." Whether it's at Mass during the Liturgy of the Word or at home poring over the Bible, time after time we find ourselves less mindful than we could be. Our ears accept the sounds of the words and our eyes glance over the shape of the letters.

But are we mindful — truly?

The best answer is hopefully at least sometimes. There are always tasks to be completed, problems weighing on our minds that we can't quite give over to God. We lose ourselves in these things instead of in Scripture. We "clock in" with Bible reading instead of "diving in."

We can never forget that the words of the Lord are spirit and life. They are the soil that quickens the seed of all stewardship. There is no mindfulness, no prayer, no graciousness, no gratitude or accountability or sense of commitment unless there is the Word.

So let us pray today for mindfulness, that our every action will be grounded in the law of God — giving it true spirit and life.

Planta tus obras en la Palabra

Una de las cosas acerca de las Escrituras es que incluso la palabra más pequeña y la frase más corta pueden ser críticas para el mensaje general. Cuando tomas un momento de tranquilidad para descansar con la Palabra, te das cuenta de la rapidez con la que la oración más mundana puede llegar y atraparte, llevándote a una contemplación más profunda de alguna verdad que ni siquiera habías considerado hasta entonces.

Pero a menudo fallamos en actuar como los israelitas en el Libro de Nehemías, parados frente a la Puerta del Agua "escuchando atentamente." Ya sea en la Misa durante la Liturgia de la Palabra o en casa estudiando detenidamente la Biblia, una y otra vez nos encontramos menos conscientes de lo que podríamos estar. Nuestros oídos aceptan los sonidos de las palabras y nuestros ojos miran la forma de las letras.

Pero ¿somos conscientes, de verdad?

La mejor respuesta, esperemos sea, al menos algunas veces. Siempre hay tareas que completar, problemas que pesan en nuestras mentes y que no podemos entregar muy bien a Dios. Nos perdemos en estas cosas en lugar de en las Escrituras. Nos "registramos" con la lectura de la Biblia en lugar de "sumergirnos."

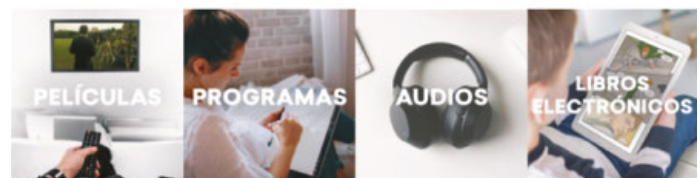
Nunca podemos olvidar que las palabras del Señor son espíritu y vida. Ellas son el suelo que aviva la semilla de toda corresponsabilidad. No hay conciencia plena, oración, gracia, gratitud, responsabilidad o sentido de compromiso a menos que exista la Palabra.

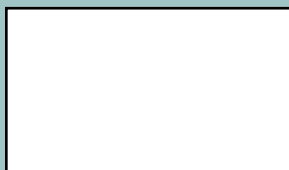

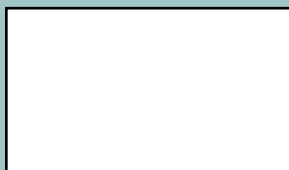
