This week, we say "Good Bye" to Lexie Wasinger, our Notre Dame apprentice for the last two years. Lexie's perky demeanor, hardworking attitude and deep faith will be missed here at St. Clare. Needless to say, two years of pandemic didn't give Lexie a typical parish experience, but like everyone else, she learned to adjust to the current reality as it unfolded.

Lexie worked in a lot of different ministries here at St. Clare Parish, including leading our Youth Group, coordinating our Confirmation preparation program, assisting with sacramental preparation for RCIA, 1st Reconciliation and 1st Communion, and a variety of other parish activities. Last week, she coordinated our 8th grade retreat and this week, will be leading the 7th grade retreat. She brings lots of joy and God's goodness into whatever she does.

The Notre Dame University apprenticeship program (Echo Program) is a two year program for students getting their Masters Degree. 
