Saints of the Week:

Blessed Luigi and Maria Beltrame Quattrocchi

Feast Day: November 25

Blessed Luigi and Maria Beltrame Quattrocchi met and were married in 1905 in Rome. This couple was known for their openness to life, their hope in the midst of difficult family situations, and their loving commitment to one another.

Luigi and Maria were blessed with four children. Their oldest became a Benedictine nun, and the next two children were called to the priesthood. Luigi and Maria received a unique gift in their fourth child, a girl named Enrichetta. From the start Maria experienced great difficulties in her pregnancy, and doctors warned that she had less than a five-percent chance of living if she gave birth to her baby, and that the baby had even less of a chance of surviving. Enrichetta was born a healthy child, and both Luigi and Maria grew in their love for one another and their love for God by trusting in His promises.

Throughout their lives, Maria and Luigi served the Church faithfully living the vows of their marriage and through their many charitable works. The family was consecrated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and prayed the rosary each evening. Because of the holiness of their lives and their particular witness to the virtue of fidelity in their marriage, in 2001 Luigi and Maria became the first married couple to be beatified together. November 25, the date of their wedding anniversary, is celebrated as their feast day.

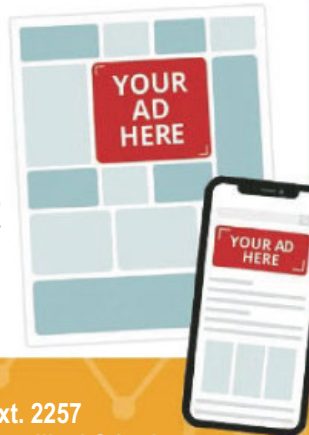
