Lives of the Saints

ST. PHILIP NERI

Feast Day: May 26

Known as the Second Apostle of Rome, St. Philip Neri was an Italian priest who founded the Congregation of the Oratory, a community of Catholic priests and lay brothers.

Before entering the priesthood, Philip studied philosophy and theology at the Sapienza and at St. Augustine's monastery and was considered a promising scholar. After 3 years of study, he suddenly left any thought of ordination and took to evangelizing in the streets of Rome. His cheerful and infectious personality gained him friends from all levels of society. He encouraged his followers to gather for discussions, studies, prayer, and charitable works for the poor.

At 34-years-old, Philip had already accomplished so much, but his spiritual director was determined that his work would be more effective as a priest. On May 23, 1551, he was ordained. He carried on his mission mainly through the confessional. He started hearing confessions before dawn and continued for hours, while men of women of all ages and social rank flocked to him. In his later years, Philip became weak and suffered from many illnesses, each of which was cured through prayer.

After spending a day hearing confessions and receiving visitors, Philip Neri suffered a hemorrhage and died on the feast of Corpus Christi in 1595. He was beatified in 1615 and canonized in 1622. Three centuries later, Cardinal John Henry Newman founded the first English-speaking house of the Oratory in London.

"We are not saints yet, but we, too, should beware. Uprightness and virtue do have their rewards, in self-respect and in respect from others, and it is easy to find ourselves aiming for the result rather than the cause. Let us aim for joy, rather than respectability. Let us make fools of ourselves from time to time, and thus see ourselves, for a moment, as the all-wise God sees us."

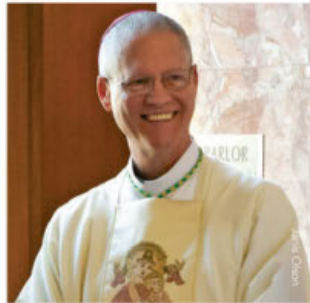

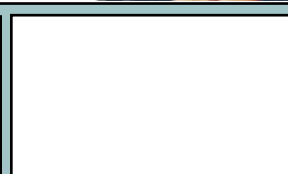
