

Lives of the Saints SAINTS PETER AND PAUL

Feast Day: June 29

On June 29, the Church celebrates the feast day of Saints Peter and Paul. As early as the year 258, there is evidence of an already lengthy tradition of celebrating the solemnities of both Saint Peter and Saint Paul on the same day. Together, the two

saints are the founders of the See of Rome, through their preaching, ministry, and martyrdom there.

Peter started life as Simon, a fisherman of Galilee and was introduced to the Lord Jesus by his brother Andrew. Jesus gave him the name Cephas (Petrus in Latin) which means "rock" because he was to become the rock upon which Christ would build His Church. Peter led the Apostles as the first Pope and ensured that the disciples kept the true faith.

Paul had been named Saul, a Pharisee and proud persecutor of Christians. Saul's conversion took place on the road to Damascus where he had an encounter with the risen Christ which blinded him. Saul continued to Damascus, where he was baptized and his sight was restored. He took the name Paul and dedicated the rest of his life to preaching the Gospel throughout Asia Minor.




