



SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST



THE REAL PRESENCE

The sixth chapter of John's Gospel contains the most astonishing and theologically illuminating reflection on the meaning of the Eucharist in the New Testament. In his discourse at the synagogue in Capernaum, Jesus says, "*I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.*" At this, many in his Jewish audience balk, and for obvious reasons. In many places in the Old Testament, the eating of an animal's flesh with blood in it is strictly forbidden. How much more, therefore, would the eating of the flesh of a man be appalling to them.

Given every opportunity to soften his speech, to explain that he is speaking only metaphorically, as he was when he told Nicodemus that one must be born again, Jesus instead intensifies his rhetoric, insisting on the literalness of his meaning: "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink." It is telling that the Greek term used for "eat" here is not the customary phagein, which describes the manner in which human beings eat, but rather trogein, which carries the sense of "gnaw" or "chew" in the manner of an animal. Once his listeners took in his meaning, the Gospel writer tells us, many returned to their former way of life and no longer accompanied him.

The doctrine of the Real Presence, which has its roots in these disturbing and wonderful words of the Lord, has always been a standing or falling point for followers of Jesus. If the Eucharist is but a symbol of Jesus, who cares? But if it is the flesh and blood of the Master, nothing could possibly be more important.



Lives of the Saints

SAINT ANTHONY OF PADUA

Feast Day: June 13

The gospel call to leave everything and follow Christ was the rule of Saint Anthony of Padua's life, during which, God called him to something new in his plan. And every time Anthony responded with renewed zeal and self-sacrificing to serve his Lord Jesus more completely.

As a very young man he decided to join the Augustinians in Lisbon, giving up a future of wealth and power to be a servant of God. Later when the bodies of the first Franciscan martyrs went through the Portuguese city where he was stationed, he was again filled with an intense longing to be one of those closest to Jesus himself: those who die for the Good News.

So Anthony entered the Franciscan Order and set out to preach to the Moors. But an illness prevented him from achieving that goal. He went to Italy and was stationed in a small hermitage where he spent most of his time praying, reading the Scriptures and doing menial tasks.

The call of God came again at an ordination where no one was prepared to speak. The humble and obedient Anthony hesitantly accepted the task. The years of searching for Jesus in prayer, of reading sacred Scripture and of serving him in poverty, chastity, and obedience had prepared Anthony to allow the Spirit to use his talents. Anthony's sermon was astounding to those who expected an unprepared speech and knew not the Spirit's power to give people words.

Recognized as a great man of prayer and a great Scripture and theology scholar, Anthony became the first friar to teach theology to the other friars. Soon he was called from that post to preach to the Albigensians in France, using his profound knowledge of Scripture and theology to convert and reassure those who had been misled by their denial of Christ's divinity and of the sacraments..

After he led the friars in northern Italy for three years, he made his headquarters in the city of Padua. He resumed his preaching and began writing sermon notes to help other preachers. On June 13, 1231 he became very ill and died after receiving the last sacraments. Anthony was canonized less than a year later and named a Doctor of the Church in 1946.
