

## WHO DO YOU SAY THAT I AM?

When Jesus inquires concerning the opinion of people in general, he refers to himself obliquely as *the Son of man.* But when he asks his disciples the question, what he says is, *"Who do you say that I am?"*...As a focus shifts from people in general to the apostles themselves, Jesus' manner of referring to himself likewise shifts from a third-person objective title to the first-person intimate pronoun... The apostles have had ample opportunity to experience the rays of Jesus' inmost being shining upon

their persons like the sun, in contrast to the multitude that have merely heard rumors about him or have projected their own expectations onto this itinerant rabbi. Therefore, Jesus' question to the disciples is not so much an official examination at the end of a period of scholastic training as it is a hopeful query by a Lover who needs to know to what extent he is known, understood, and accepted in his deepest identity by those he loves, those to whom he has been at pains to manifest himself. To the happy (and indifferent) eclecticism of "John the Baptist, Elijah, Jeremiah, or one of the prophets," Jesus reacts by saying to those sitting by him: "But you, my dear friends: you who know the contour of my face and the sound of my voice...Could *you* pick me out in the confusion of a dark room full of prophets as your (and God's) one and only Beloved? Am I present to you as the total person that I am? It is, after all, to reveal the Father that I came, and you can know the Father only if you know who *I* am!"

*Lives of the Saints* ST. AUGUSTINE OF HIPPO Feast Day: August 28

A Christian at 33, a priest at 36, a bishop at 41: Many people are familiar with the biographical sketch of Augustine of Hippo, sinner turned saint. But to get to really know the man is a rewarding experience.

There quickly surfaces the intensity with which he lived his life, whether his path led away from or toward God. The tears of his mother, the instructions of Ambrose and, most of all, God himself speaking to him in the Scriptures, redirected Augustine's love of

life to a life of love.

Having been so deeply immersed in creature-pride of life in his early days and having drunk deeply of its bitter dregs, it is not surprising that Augustine should have turned, with a holy fierceness, against the many demon-thrusts rampant in his day. His times were truly decadent: politically, socially, morally. He was both feared and loved, like the Master. The perennial criticism leveled against him: a fundamental rigorism.

In his day, Augustine providentially fulfilled the office of prophet. Like Jeremiah and other greats, he was hardpressed but could not keep quiet. "I say to myself, I will not mention him/I will speak in his name no more/But then it becomes like fire burning in my heart/imprisoned in my bones/I grow weary holding it in/I cannot endure it" (Jeremiah 20:9).
