The Vineyard of the Lord: Lucas Cranach the Younger

REMEMBERING THE LANDOWNER AND HIS GOODNESS

Scripture is full of the commands *remember* and *do not forget*. The Ten Commandments likewise begin not with a commandment but with a reminder: *I am the Lord your God*. After all, if we forget that truth then we should not hope to keep the commandments. The parable of the wicked tenants presents Israel's tragic failure to remember. The parable's landowner represents God, and the vineyard he built is Jerusalem, or Israel in general. The tenants—Israel's leaders—failed to remember that he was the One who made their vineyard. They had, as Isaiah warned, *forgotten the God of their salvation*... We face the same danger as the wicked tenants. When forgetfulness creeps in—when we forget that it is he who made us and redeemed us—we begin to view ourselves as independent from him. We fall into a false sense of self-sufficiency. We grow to resent his commands as inconveniences, intrusions, and violations of our autonomy. His messengers become annoying to us, and we dismiss them...

The Church constantly guards us against this forgetfulness. As a good Mother she forever reminds us of the Lord, his works, and his law...She persistently says in effect, *take heed lest you forget the Lord* (Dt 6:12). Through her priests and bishops she puts our Lord's teachings before us always. She points to what he has already accomplished, reminding us that it was he who established us as his vineyard. At the same time she looks to the future and makes us "remember" that moment when he will come again and gather his harvest.

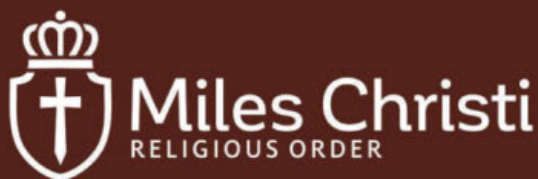

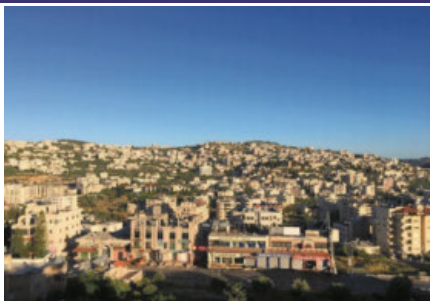

Lives of the Saints

ST. DENIS AND COMPANIONS

Feast Day: October 9

This martyr and patron of France is regarded as the first bishop of Paris. His popularity is due to a series of legends, especially those connecting him with the great abbey church of St. Denis in Paris. He was for a time confused with the writer now called Pseudo-Dionysius.

The best hypothesis contends that Denis was sent to Gaul from Rome in the third century and beheaded, along with his companions priest Rusticus and deacon Eleutherius, in the persecution under Emperor Valerius in 258.

According to one of the legends, after he was martyred on Montmartre—literally, “mountain of martyrs”—in Paris, he carried his head to a village northeast of the city. Saint Genevieve built a basilica over his tomb at the beginning of the sixth century.

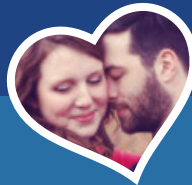

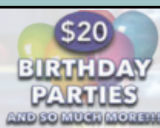
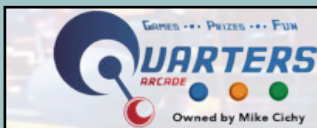
