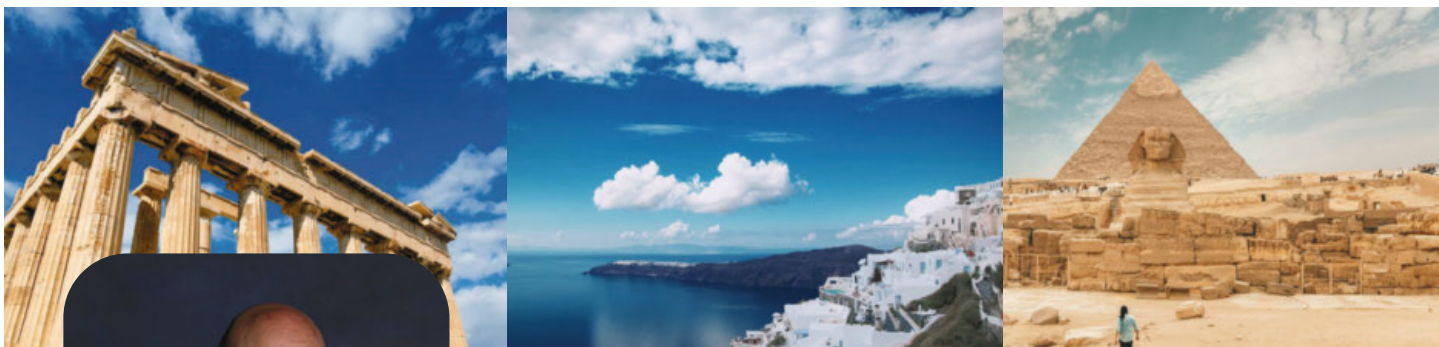

Pilgrimage to Egypt & Greece

With Deacon Bill Hamlin — June 11-21, 2024

Cost: \$4,695/person; includes meals, hotels, round-trip airfare*, ground transportation, sightseeing w/licensed local Guides.

**DOES NOT include ticket from Athens to CAI (around \$250)*

Athens: Visit iconic sites like the Parthenon and Mars Hill. Bus tour includes Constitution Square, the Temple of Zeus, and the Old Olympic Stadium. Spend the afternoon for personal exploration. Conclude with dinner and overnight stay in Athens.

3-Night Mediterranean Cruise: sail from Athens to the quaint isle of Mykonos where you will have time to experience the waterfront lined with shops and cafes.

Kusadasi, Patmos: Arrive in Kusanagi, Turkey and embark on excursion to Ephesus, where Paul ministered. Ephesus features impressive ancient remains, including the Agora, Theater, Stadium, Library of Celsus, and the Temple of Diana ruins. Later, sail to Patmos for another excursion to the Monastery of St. John and the Grotto of the Apocalypse, where St. John received his revelations.

Heraklion, Santorini: Morning in Crete, with optional shore excursion. Briefly explore Heraklion and visit the Knossos excavations, revealing a civilization dating back to 4000 BC. In the afternoon, you will disembark on Santorini, known as the most breathtaking Greek island, with its stunning whitewashed villages like Fira (Thira) perched on volcanic cliffs, accessible by cable-car or mule.

Corinth, Athens: Visit Ancient Corinth, where Paul preached for a year and a half. Explore its Archaeological Museum, Forum, Temples, and the famous Bema where Paul faced accusations. Finally, stop in Cochlea, where Paul ended his second missionary journey.

Egypt: Fly to Cairo, Egypt and check-in to a Hotel for the night. Explore the Great Pyramids of Giza, The Sphinx, Old Cairo, Abu Serga—the oldest of its churches. The next day, visit the Egyptian Museum containing the world's most extensive collection of pharaonic antiquities, 9th century Mosque of Mohammed Ali and the Citadel—The Saladin Citadel located on Mokattam hill, and the colorful Khan El Khalili Bazaar of the world's oldest bazaars. ****Optional Nile Cruise Dinner Boat****

Lives of the Saints

ST. GABRIEL OF OUR LADY OF SORROWS

Feast Day: February 27

Born in Italy into a large family and baptized Francis, Saint Gabriel lost his mother when he was only four years old. He was educated by the Jesuits and, having been cured twice of serious illnesses, came to believe that God was calling him to the religious life. Young Francis wished to join the Jesuits but was turned down, probably because of his age, not yet 17. Following the death of a sister to cholera, his resolve to enter religious life became even stronger and he was accepted by the Passionists. Upon entering the novitiate he was given the name Gabriel of Our Lady

of Sorrows.

Ever popular and cheerful, Gabriel quickly was successful in his effort to be faithful in little things. His spirit of prayer, love for the poor, consideration of the feelings of others, exact observance of the Passionist Rule as well as his bodily penances—always subject to the will of his wise superiors—made a deep impression on everyone.

His superiors had great expectations of Gabriel as he prepared for the priesthood, but after only four years of religious life symptoms of tuberculosis appeared. Ever obedient, he patiently bore the painful effects of the disease and the restrictions it required, seeking no special notice. He died peacefully on February 27, 1862, at age 24, having been an example to both young and old.

Saint Gabriel of Our Lady of Sorrows was canonized in 1920.

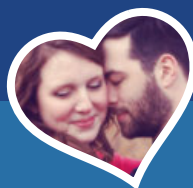

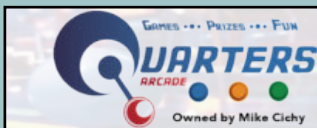
