

### CONFIDENCE IN THE ONE WHO DIED FOR THE PEOPLE

"Jesus went to excess in order to show us his love. He could have saved us any number of ways—all it would have taken was a drop of blood, a tear, a prayer; it wasn't necessary that he die. But what would have been enough for justice was not sufficient for love. We deserved chains and ropes, and he wanted to be bound over in place of us; the insults and scourging should have been ours, and he underwent them for us; the sentence of condemnation was pronounced against us, but he accepted it in our stead. Lastly, the lot reserved for us was eternal death with the torments of hell, but he, in order to free us from this, chose to die in prolonged agony on a gallows without any relief.

I too was among the traitors of your death, O Jesus! By my sin I put you to death, but I do not even want to think that you would deprive me of your forgiveness. Never! Your wounds call out to me, your arms invite me, your wounded heart offers me refuge. Here I am, then, in your presence, O Jesus Crucified! I ask for your mercy, I ask for your forgiveness. And you, O Mother of Sorrows, who had your beloved Son taken from you, do not permit that I also should be taken from you forever: unworthy though I be, I am always your son."





### **Lives of the Saints** ST. PETER REGALADO Feast Day: March 30

Peter lived at a very busy time in history. The Great Western Schism (1378-1417) was settled at the Council of Constance (1414-1418). France and England were fighting the Hundred Years' War, and in 1453, the Byzantine Empire was completely wiped out by the loss of Constantinople to the Turks. At Peter's death, the age of printing had just begun in Germany, and Columbus's arrival in the New World was less than 40 years away.

Peter came from a wealthy and pious family in Valladolid, Spain. At the age of 13, he was allowed to enter the Conventual Franciscans. Shortly after his ordination, he was made superior of the friary in Aguilar. He became part of a group of friars who wanted to lead a life of greater poverty and penance. In 1442, he was appointed head of all the Spanish Franciscans in his reform group.

Peter led the friars by his example. A special love of the poor and the sick characterized Peter. Miraculous stories are told about his charity to the poor. For example, the bread never seemed to run out as long as Peter had hungry people to feed. Throughout most of his life, Peter went hungry; he lived only on bread and water.

Immediately after his death on March 30, 1456, his grave became a place of pilgrimage. Peter was canonized in 1746.
