



# JUNE 16, 2024 11<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



#### CULTIVATING THE LAND OF OUR SOUL

It is not enough for the human heart to devote the whole day or even six days of the week to binding sheaves: for it to be fully satisfied there must be a possibility, either in the evening or at the end of the toilsome week, for him to offer his sheaves to God. And so work for six days always prepares for the seventh day of the Lord. Holy days are *the voice of one crying in the wilderness: make straight the way of the Lord* (Mk1:3). They remind us to pay homage to God, the Father of all creation, of life, and of grace; to tear ourselves away from matter, to free ourselves from its powerful influence, to realize that it is not creation that governs man but man creation, to remember the service of God, which is the most wonderful and fitting thing we can do, to come to him through our own sanctification, and to become like God. All this is the special task of the feast day.

All these tasks have to be put within man's reach by a day that is free from ordinary, everyday work... The fulfillment one's duties toward God and the fulfillment of the needs of the mind and the heart are the main aims of freedom from work, a freedom that should do good to both soul and body. For the rest on Sunday or a feast day does not mean unproductive idleness but is "rest from labor, consecrated by religion. Repose united with religious observance disposes man to forget for a while the business of this daily life, and to turn his thought to heavenly things and to the worship which he so strictly owes to the eternal Deity" (Pope Leo XIII). Sundays and holy days are meant to remind us that, in addition to temporal work, there are other labors in the vineyard of our own soul.



#### NEW MINISTRY COMING TO STAR:

# Ministry for the Aging and Infirm



With the approval of Father Lappe, and under the spiritual direction of Deacon Bill Hamlin, Our Lady Star of the Sea has formed the Ministry for the Aging and Infirm. For the past several months the committee has researched and determined that there is a significant need for Catholic-centered care among our aging Catholic population. This includes not just those in our combined Star and Holy Trinity parishes, but other senior Catholics in Kitsap County as well.

The ministry's ultimate goal envisions both a broad spectrum of caring for the physical and spiritual needs of Catholic seniors, while at the same time providing some respite care for their caregivers. While our long-term plan is far reaching, the committee will soon begin providing a once a week socially interactive daytime and lunch gathering for this population.

Within the next two weeks, a short two-question survey will be published in our bulletin to determine if the perceived need actually exists within Star, and if it would be beneficial to our parish family. We will eventually expand participation to Holy Trinity and other Catholics within Kitsap County.

# Lives of the Saints ST. THOMAS MORE

Feast Day: June 22

His belief that no lay ruler has jurisdiction over the Church of Christ cost Thomas More his life.

Beheaded on Tower Hill, London, on July 6, 1535, More steadfastly refused to approve King Henry VIII's divorce and remarriage and establishment of the Church of England. Described as "a man for all seasons," More was a literary scholar, eminent lawyer, gentleman, father of four children, and chancellor of England. An intensely spiritual man, he would not support the king's divorce from Catherine of Aragon in order to marry Anne

Boleyn. Nor would he acknowledge Henry as supreme head of the Church in England, breaking with Rome, and denying the pope as head.

More was committed to the Tower of London to await trial for treason: not swearing to the Act of Succession and the Oath of Supremacy. Upon conviction, More declared he had all the councils of Christendom and not just the council of one realm to support him in the decision of his conscience.

Four hundred years later in 1935, Thomas More was canonized a saint of God. Few saints are more relevant to our time. In the year 2000, in fact, Pope John Paul II named him patron of political leaders. The supreme diplomat and counselor, he did not compromise his own moral values in order to please the king, knowing that true allegiance to authority is not blind acceptance of everything that authority wants. King Henry himself realized this and tried desperately to win his chancellor to his side because he knew More was a man whose approval counted, a man whose personal integrity no one questioned. But when Thomas More resigned as chancellor, unable to approve the two matters that meant most to Henry, the king had to get rid of him.
