

THE BREAD FROM HEAVEN

In raining down bread from heaven upon the whole Israelite community, the Lord wanted them to "know that I, the Lord, am your God." WHAT DO STEPHEN MINISTERS DO?

Stephen Ministers are parishioners who go through 50 hours of training in providing high-quality Christian care to individuals experiencing a crisis or challenge such as divorce, grief, terminal illness, job loss, hospitalization, relocation, or loneliness – or just the occasional challenges of life. Stephen Ministers are each assigned to a care receiver and meet with that care receiver for about an hour a week. This caring relationship will last for as long as the care receiver needs it.

With two Priests for over 2,000 families in our churches, it would be impossible for our Priests to meet every single need of every single person. While some crises require the care of a Priest, some needs can be met by these lay ministers. Stephen Ministry expands the care we can offer by equipping and organizing members to provide Christian care, bringing Christ's love to those who most need it.

Lives of the Saints ST. JOHN VIANNEY Feast Day: August 4

Among the best-known readers of hearts is St. John Vianney, the Curé of Ars. Assigned to the most backwater parish of his diocese, he brought an electrifying ardor for God and neighbor. He was a simple preacher who condemned sin and called people to embrace the merciful love of God.

Penitents came to him from far and wide and waited hours to make their confession. John also traveled willingly, in all sorts of weather, to assist his fellow priests at their parishes. He received supernatural insight for this multitude of penitents and was often able to remind people of long-forgotten or hidden sins. He also knew the needs of people waiting in line. One story tells how he stepped out of the confessional to call a woman to the front because she was a mother of many and strapped for time. Another time he encountered a friend returning from a journey where he had been dabbling in then-fashionable occult "games". Fr. Vianney recognized the state of his soul instantly and told him: "The day before yesterday you had dealings with the devil. Come to confession!"

His miraculous ability did not make him proud at all. On the contrary, he repeatedly tried to flee from his parish to do penance for his "poor life." He died in 1859 and was canonized in 1925.
