Therefore, if any are to approach this sacrament worthily, they must partake in the spirit so as to eat in the acknowledgment of faith and to receive in the devotion of love, whereby they will not be transforming Christ into himself, but instead will be passing over into the mystical body of Christ.

WHAT DO STEPHEN MINISTERS DO?

Stephen Ministers are parishioners who go through 50 hours of training in providing high-quality Christian care to individuals experiencing a crisis or challenge such as divorce, grief, terminal illness, job loss, hospitalization, relocation, or loneliness – or just the occasional challenges of life. Stephen Ministers are each assigned to a care receiver and meet with that care receiver for about an hour a week. This caring relationship will last for as long as the care receiver needs it.

With two Priests for over 2,000 families in our churches, it would be impossible for our Priests to meet every single need of every single person. While some crises require the care of a Priest, some needs can be met by these lay ministers. Stephen Ministry expands the care we can offer by equipping and organizing members to provide Christian care, bringing Christ's love to those who most need it.

Lives of the Saints

POPE ST. PIUS X

Feast Day: August 21

Pope Pius X is perhaps best remembered for his encouragement of the frequent reception of Holy Communion, especially by children.

The second of 10 children in a poor Italian family, Joseph Sarto became Pius X at age 68. He was one of the 20th century's greatest popes.

Ever mindful of his humble origin, Pope Pius stated, "I was born poor, I lived poor, I will die poor." He was embarrassed by some of the pomp of the papal court. "Look how they have dressed me up," he said in tears to an old friend. To another, "It is a penance

to be forced to accept all these practices. They lead me around surrounded by soldiers like Jesus when he was seized in Gethsemani."

Interested in politics, Pope Pius encouraged Italian Catholics to become more politically involved. One of his first papal acts was to end the supposed right of governments to interfere by veto in papal elections—a practice that reduced the freedom of the 1903 conclave which had elected him.

In 1905, when France renounced its agreement with the Holy See and threatened confiscation of Church property if governmental control of Church affairs were not granted, Pius X courageously rejected the demand.

While he did not author a famous social encyclical as his predecessor had done, he denounced the ill treatment of indigenous peoples on the plantations of Peru, sent a relief commission to Messina after an earthquake, and sheltered refugees at his own expense.

On the 11th anniversary of his election as pope, Europe was plunged into World War I. Pius had foreseen it, but it killed him. "This is the last affliction the Lord will visit on me. I would gladly give my life to save my poor children from this ghastly scourge." He died a few weeks after the war began, and was canonized in 1954.





