



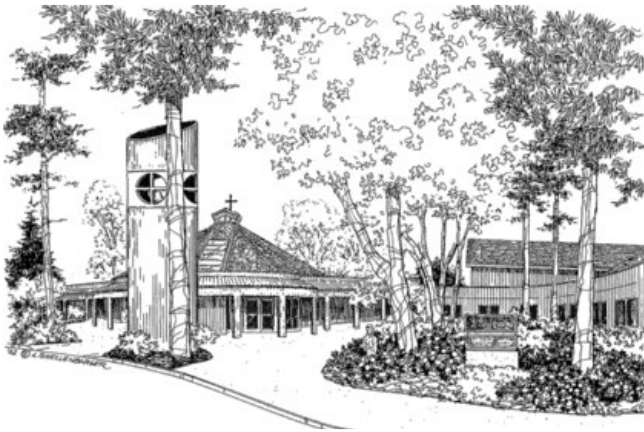

Called to Serve

Of the two 'paradigms of governance' namely, worldly and godly, while the former centers on power and authority, the latter is obviously expressed in service. Jesus never minces his words when it comes to portray the primary quality to become great: to become a servant of and for others. A servant of God is called, "To inspire, not to legislate; to awaken, not to coerce; to love, not to regulate; to serve, and certainly not to be served". The Divine Master poignantly pointed out the purpose of His coming into the world: "I came, not to be served, but to serve and give my life for you", and invites us to emulate Him.

The disciples, James and John, arguably among the closest ones to Jesus, apparently missed the point by having their mother recommend the honorary positions for them in the kingdom. The response was an antidote to what they expected: to drink the cup of suffering. Startled as they were, they learnt a new lesson on service and sacrifice, the two inseparable realities in the life of a disciple who wants to commit.

As human beings we all exercise some power over others. Let us ask ourselves: Are we mad about power or do we possess true authority? Do we induce fear through power or earn respect through authority? Do we love and serve those entrusted to our care? Do we realize that God is the source of all power and that it is He who gives us that power, as an opportunity to serve? May God give us the grace to serve with love!

Once again let us thank all the wonderful people who helped us with a special event in our parish/family. Yes, it was a wonderful experience of fellowship and solidarity when we came together as the members of St. Francis when we celebrated the annual feast of our patron St. Francis, with the International Food Festival on Saturday, October 5. It would not have been possible without the coordinated efforts of all the families that spent lots of time and energy to make this happen. Events like this would certainly serve the purpose of living our faith in action and become powerful witnesses to the community in Sherwood and beyond. May God bless us all!

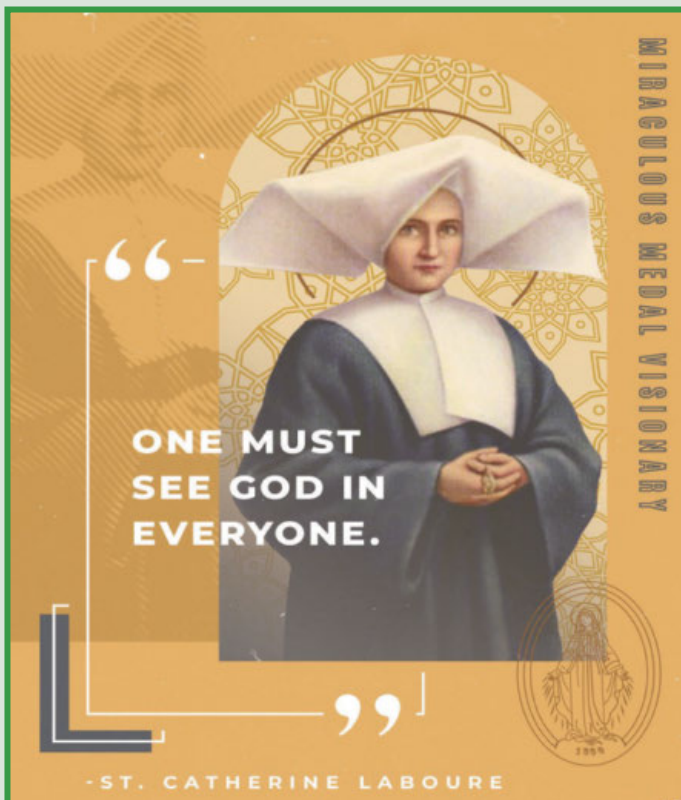

News from our Math Program at St. Francis School

The new school year is off to a fantastic start! I thought I would take a moment to share news from our middle school math program at St. Francis. I enjoy teaching all of these classes each week and watching your children grow in the area of math understanding each year!

Our fifth graders are getting a small taste of middle school by moving classrooms for math and science classes in their day. They are studying different ways of multiplication including powers, exponents and factors for numbers. They are a great group of students who have so much enthusiasm in the day!

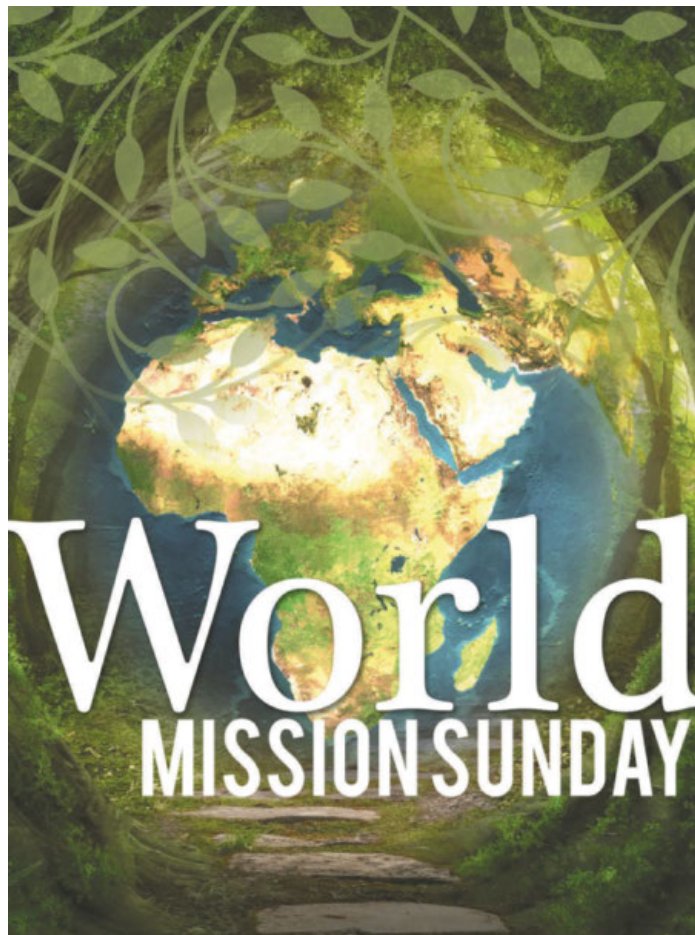
In sixth grade, we are studying ratios and rates and how these relate to coordinate plane graphs and functions. We will continue with percent, fractions and decimals and how these numbers relate to each other.

The seventh grade class is working on ratios and proportions, direct variation and linear functions. We will be moving into percent, percent of change, and sales taxes in the next few weeks.

Eighth graders are studying the real numbers and how they can be expressed in a variety of ways. We have been converting fractions and decimals, converting negative exponents and using scientific notation to compute large and small numbers.

Algebra I students are beginning to solve linear equations, including absolute value equations. We will also work on dimensional analysis to simplify rates and ratios.

All of these classes are augmented by our **ALEKS (Assessment and Learning in Knowledge Spaces) math program** allowing our students to work ahead at their own pace. It uses artificial intelligence to find the areas all students need to work on in math at many levels and is specific to each child. Students who need extra help can join our math homework club each Tuesday afternoon.
