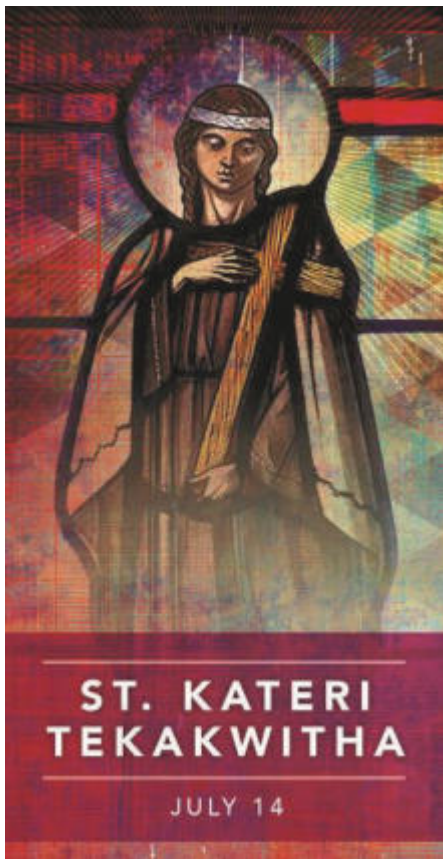

The hymnals have been returned to the pews for use again. At this time we will not be printing extra song sheets as the cost of paper has gone up.

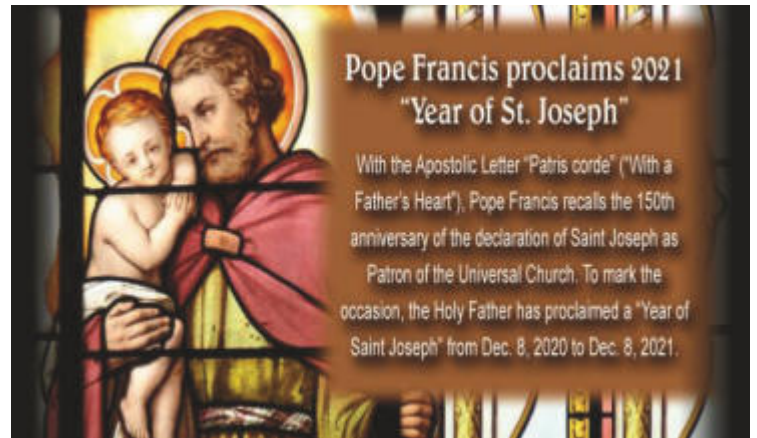
Holy Water can be used for blessing oneself via your hand.

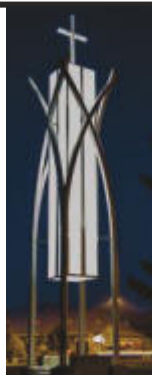

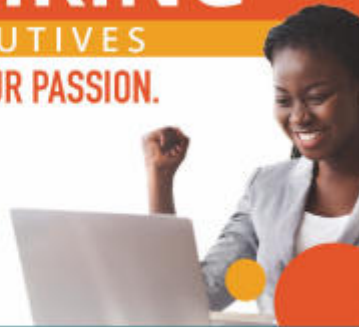
