

## <u>Fork & Spoon</u>

After a long hiatus due to the pandemic, Fork and Spoon Bozeman's community meals program (sometimes called Bozeman's 'soup kitchen') is resuming its regular evening dinner service on Sunday through Thursday nights of each week.

Resurrection University Parish has a long history of volunteering at Fork and Spoon dinners, extending back to when it was called the "Community Café," even winning a community award and supporting Fork and Spoon financially during the height of the pandemic.

This year, given the days Fork and Spoon is open balanced against parishioner's weekly schedules, we've asked for volunteers from 4:30-7:45 PM on **Jan 23rd** and the 2nd Thursday of each month (**Feb 10th, Mar 10th, Apr 14th, May 12th and June 9th**).

Typically, Resurrection has volunteered as Platers (putting the ordered food on plates), Servers (taking food out to patrons), Greeters (welcoming and seating patrons), and a Dishwasher.

Specifically, we need 7 volunteers 14 years or older to help, each night (though you'd only be volunteering for one night, not all 6). It's a very tangible way to act out our Gospel call to serve "the least of God's people..."




