The word "tithe" means a tenth or 10%. This is what we are asked to give back to God in gratitude for our many blessings. For us Catholics, a good rule of thumb would be: Give 5% to the parish; (4 % to the general, 1% Annual Catholic Appeal) and the remaining 5 % can be distributed between local and international charities i.e., Catholic Relief Services, Gallatin Valley Food


