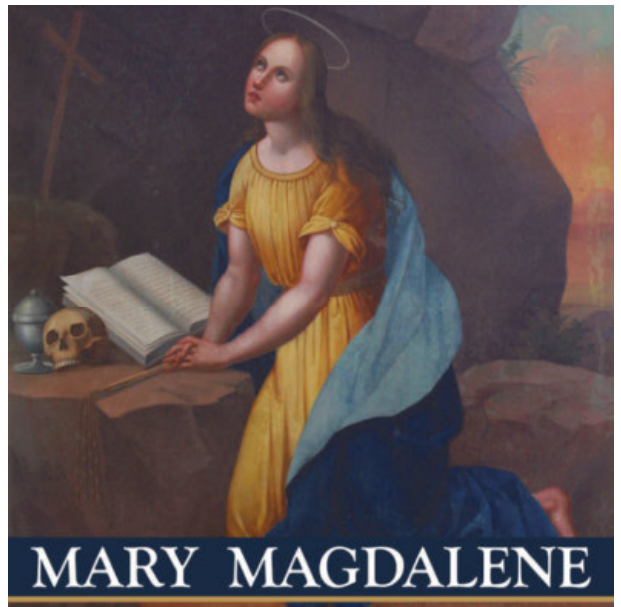

Come join the Resurrection's Creation Care Team in our community garden for the 2022 growing season. Thanks to Land Stewardship, our growing space includes nine raised beds (4 feet x 8 feet each) along the west side of the church property. The produce will be shared among shareholders. Instead of renting a specific garden box, the communal gardening arrangement allows us to coordinate what we raise to optimize food output. 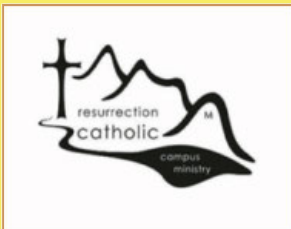

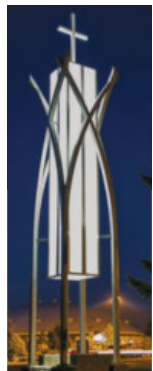
