Responsorial Psalm: God mounts his throne to shouts of joy, a blare of trumpets for the Lord.


2nd Reading: Hebrews 9:24-29; 10:19-23

Ascension Moved

Very often, when we get to this week in the liturgical calendar, I will get questions about the date of the celebration of the Ascension of Our Lord. That is, why we didn't celebrate it last Thursday and why today is not the 7th Sunday of Easter instead. It is kind of funny how even though we have not celebrated Ascension on Thursday--and neither has most of the country--for decades, we nonetheless have in our Catholic consciousness the idea of "Ascension Thursday." So, what is going on? Why did it change?

Several decades ago the Church gave greater license to local Bishops (and the newly invented national conferences of bishops) to adjust the liturgical calendar in certain ways to accommodate the needs of the Catholic faithful in their dioceses. A major part of this was the ability to reduce the number of holy days of obligation overall, dispense the obligation to assist at Mass if an otherwise obligatory holy day fell too near a Sunday, and the ability to transfer certain feast days to that do not fall on Sunday to the nearest Sunday. These decisions are made by the Bishop in order to not overburden people with too many consecutive days of being obligated to come to Mass, or to cause excessive difficulties with their work schedules, but also to enable us to celebrate important feasts even if they do not naturally fall on a Sunday. This week and a few weeks hence we celebrate two feasts, Ascension and Corpus Christi, that ordinarily fall on Thursdays, but our Archbishop (actually, the Archbishop before most of us were even born) has chosen to transfer them to Sundays. Indeed, most bishops in America have done so; I think only Nebraska and parts of New England still keep Ascension on Thursday and I am not sure whether or not they move Corpus Christi from its Thursday.

I suppose it is a little late now, but if celebrating Ascension on a Thursday is important to you, next year you would either need to travel to one of the aforementioned regions (or another country) or find a Mass in the ancestral form of our Roman Rite (such as is celebrated at St Joseph).
