Confirmation

The next Sacrament is Confirmation. This may surprise us Americans, who are so accustomed to Reconciliation and Communion preceding Confirmation. However, it was not so in the beginning, so to speak. Holy Communion is the ultimate and ongoing Sacrament of initiation/full membership in the Church, and virtually always and everywhere, Confirmation preceded First Communion. However, a bit over a century ago Pope St Pius X, who was concerned about so many Catholics abstaining from Holy Communion out of reverential fear or a feeling of unworthiness (not to mention those who casually and habitually persisted in sin), lowered the First Communion age to 7 years old (it had been in early adolescence). Some countries lowered the Confirmation age accordingly, but America did not for whatever reason. Since, some Dioceses have corrected this (For example, in Eastern Washington, in the Diocese of Spokane the bishop confirms the children and gives them their First Holy Communion at the same Mass) or at least moved in the right direction (For those who missed the shift: the Archdiocese of Seattle now celebrates Confirmation in 7th grade).

The reason for all of this is due to the oddities of history. Confirmation is most properly celebrated by a bishop (though a priest may celebrate it with permission). In the beginning—and even today in Eastern Catholic Churches—Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Communion were always celebrated together and presided over by the bishop regardless of the age of the person receiving them (even infants). As the Church grew, the bishop could not personally attend every Baptism. In the East, the solution was that the priest would just celebrate all three sacraments; in the West, we would simply baptize the baby and then the bishop would Confirm and give Communion, the next time he was in town (if the bishop did happen to baptize someone, he would still confirm and give Communion, though). Once someone was confirmed (regardless of age) First Communion would occur. Later in history, the Precious Blood stopped commonly being offered to the laity (to combat a heresy, not because of the Black Plague, as you may have heard) and so infants, who cannot chew and so only received from the Chalice, were no longer given Communion. In the centuries before and after this, the Confirmation age (and thus First Communion) for those not baptized by the bishop was creeping older and older, and eventually even bishops stopped confirming at Baptisms and everyone was confirmed at an older age (generally 12-16, whenever the Bishop came to town) and First Communion followed after that.

This moving of Confirmation through the years, as well as the errors introduced by Luther and the other Protestants led to a number of confusions about what Confirmation is and does. However, this is getting long. I will write a part II on the Theology of Confirmation next week.
