My brothers and sisters in Christ, the Church at last is born through the fulfillment of the Risen Lord Jesus Christ’s promise to the disciples and the whole world. Jesus returned to the Father and kept His promise to send the Advocate, the Helper, the *Paraclete*, the Holy Spirit, to be with us until the end of time. On the day of Pentecost, “...suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim.” (Acts 2:2-4)


We know from this event that The Holy Spirit will enable us to proclaim *as* He deems necessary. Sometimes we can get ahead of ourselves thinking that prophecy can be willed by us-when and how we want it. St. Peter reminds us in 2 Peter 1:21, that, “...no prophecy ever came through human will; but rather human beings moved by the Holy Spirit spoke under the influence of God.” Today, Pentecost Sunday, we celebrate the great manifestation of the works of the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit will guide us in all truth. (John 16:12) Remember, Pilate said to Jesus in questioning Him, “Quid est veritas?” (John 18:38) Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. If we want to go where Jesus is, glorified in heaven, then we must follow Him. Where He is, we hope to be one day. Until then, the Holy Spirit will be our guide in this earthly pilgrimage. Of course, we are free to follow or reject this invitation to be with Jesus for all eternity, and many people have rejected the invitation. The Devil has made his choice. Following him can only lead to destruction, regardless of what temporary power and prestige he has falsely promised those who reject Jesus. God does not have to punish people who reject Him. Sin has its own punishments.

We have been reminded in the last few weeks to remain in Jesus, and He will abide in us. God always invites, and He patiently waits for our response. He does not impose His love upon us but allows us to choose. The gift of love and His abiding presence are meant to be received and shared. However, at times, when we allow the problems of our world to overwhelm us, we close the eyes of our faith to His presence in our lives and those around us. This can paralyze and stifle our ability to love as God loves. On the other hand, we can be mesmerized by the fantastic event of the Pentecost (like fireworks on July 4<sup>th</sup>) so that we ignore the ordinary events in our lives. Pentecost is about the Holy Spirit life in each one of us. Baptism, Holy Communion, Confirmation, and the other sacraments we receive are all Pentecostal moments that usher in the life of God in us.



## Summer 2021 Continuing Education The Franciscan Spiritual and Social Vision - On-Line Courses

**June 21-25 DR. MAUREEN DAY**

### The Challenges and Blessings of Catholic Family Life Today

With its foundation in Pope Francis' apostolic exhortation, *Amoris Laetitia* [The Joy of Love], this continuing-education course will examine the American family's social role through a theological lens. Specifically, this course will explore the stresses and graces American families encounter. It will also discuss the ways parishes can better serve families as well as generate ways to invite families to become active in their Church and world. Dr. Maureen Day is the Assistant Professor of Religion and Society at the Franciscan School of Theology in San Diego, CA. She was a theologian at the Diocese of San Diego's synod on the family and is married with two children.

### Francis of Assisi: His Life and Historical Setting


Setting this week within the context of Francis' life journey, the course will reflect on the relationship between his experience of the Spirit, his mission in society, and the articulation of this experience in his writings and actions. The hope is to present for the contemporary believer a method for moving from the experience of life's journey, to Gospel interpretation, to mission in the world. Some themes, among others, will be emphasized with reference to the writings of Pope Francis: (1) the meaning of "encounter"; (2) the "contemplative gaze"; (3) the personalization of the poor; (4) the "grace of working"; (5) the "field hospital" of the Church; (6) the sharing in Christ's redemption. Selections from Francis' writings and some secondary articles will be provided.

### Francis and Clare of Assisi: Writing and Charism

Francis of Assisi has left us a remarkable collection of writings, ranging from meditations on the words of Christ to norms for organizing life in a small community. This course will examine the full range of those texts, some 30 in all, from the saint's autographs (those that survive in his own handwriting) to fragments of his "lost" writings contained in the writings of Clare of Assisi and others. Over the course of an intense week, we will study his *Letters, Rules, Prayers and Admonitions*, learning about their medieval historical context, and reflecting on their insights about living according to the Gospel then and now.

### The Book of Psalms: A Franciscan Approach

Most will readily acknowledge the importance of the psalms and their place as spiritual masterpieces. If we have any doubts, we need to look no further than the gospels where no book from the Old Testament is more frequently cited. As part of a book, our understanding of the structure of that book will help us to better appreciate the individual psalms. Moving from the general to the specific, we will examine the psalms as a book before returning to types of psalms. Then we will try to offer some strategies for appreciating how the psalms encourage us to find our refuge in a God of abundance. When we respond to the God of abundance with love and gratitude as the thanksgiving psalms urge, we have a sure antidote to indifference and discouragement.





The Mystagoga Period and the 2020-2021 R.C.I.A. Process will conclude on Pentecost Sunday, May 23, with a celebration from 11:30-12:30pm. Please meet in the Narthex by the Baptismal Font. Sponsors and family members are welcome.

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.) is the process that welcomes you to join the Catholic faith community and introduces you to the beliefs and practices of the Church. If you are not baptized, the process leads to the reception of the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. If you are Baptized in another Christian tradition, the process invites you to participate fully in the church through the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.

If you are an adult looking to learn more about or to be initiated into the Catholic faith, need to prepare for a missed sacrament, or are a lifelong Catholic looking for a refresher course, then the R.C.I.A. can help.

During each R.C.I.A. session we spend time answering your questions about the Catholic faith, reviewing the Scripture readings from Mass, and discussing the current chapter in our book.
