

### **WELCOME!**

Dear friends in Christ,

This weekend we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord. It closes out the Christmas season and is an opportune time for us to recall our own baptism. Most likely you were baptized as an infant, but for some, the call to the waters of new life came later in life as an adult. Regardless of age, the Sacrament of Baptism cleanses us of original sin and inaugurates into a way of life. As we hear John the Baptist say in today's Gospel, "He (Jesus) will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire." Thus it is we are baptized in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and with that comes a mandate to live our lives worthy of our calling. Every day we should strive to live that out in a more authentic and purposeful way. What a glorious mission God has entrusted to us!

As we begin 2022 we have several events planned to help us live out our baptismal call at CtR. Or, I should say, we HAD several events planned. This latest spike in the Omicron variant that we are seeing is playing a bit of havoc with our schedule. It's not a total upending like we saw in 2020, but we are going to have to be flexible and prepared for some of our planned events to be postponed. Fortunately, all indications are that we should be past the spike relatively soon, hopefully by later this month or early February, so I don't think the disruption will cause us too much trouble.

Our Morning of Prayer with Fr. Orrin Halepeska, which was planned for yesterday, had to be scrapped when Fr. Orrin tested positive for COVID this past week. He's doing better, and we're working to find a new date that will fit his schedule. We'll keep you posted. Likewise we had a Stewardship event planned with the leaders of our various ministries and groups here in the parish that is also being moved to a new date to be determined. We also rescheduled a high school Confirmation retreat originally planned for this weekend.

I have also decided that it is in the best interest of us all that the Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) discernment of new members scheduled for Jan. 13 be moved to Thursday, Feb. 10 at 6:30 p.m. A discernment works best when we can gather comfortably to speak and listen to one another and the work of the Holy Spirit. Some might feel hesitant coming forward now with the given conditions, but hopefully in February we will be in a much better place where those who wish we'll feel safe about gathering and speaking in public again. Our returning members of the PPC will handle things in the interim. It's all about being flexible, and if we've learned anything the past two years, I trust it is that!

One event that is moving forward is planned is our small-group video evangelization series, "The Search," from the Augustine Institute hosted by Chris Stefanick. It's an invitation to all seekers, wanderers, and searchers, which I suppose is all of us, who have "big picture" questions about faith and meaning, like: Why are we here? What is the purpose of life? Who is God and what does He have to do with me? This series is perfect for anyone looking to return to their faith in the new year or wants to learn more about being faithful in our modern world. It begins this Thursday, Jan. 13 and will run for seven weeks. For more information and to register, visit www.ctrcc.com/thesearch or contact Camilla MacKenzie in our parish office.

Ministries and organizations will make their own determination about their schedule this month, so I highly encourage you to check your Flocknote email notices about any possible changes. To the ministry leaders themselves, please let our office know if you adjust your calendar in any way so that we might update our parish master calendar as well. That way we can avoid future scheduling problems when it comes to booking meeting space. Thanks very much for your cooperation in this regard.

Finally, let me remind those of you who are hesitant to come to Mass because you are at high-risk of contracting Covid that we will continue to offer our livestream of Mass each day at 9 a.m. I understand we had a jump in the number of online viewers last Sunday and that's not surprising. Though Cardinal DiNardo has lifted the dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass as of last week, those who are at risk (and our elderly and those with health issues fall into that category) do not have to attend. Of course, please do come when it is safe for you to do so, but until then we are happy to have you join us electronically. I got a very nice note last week from an older couple who wrote how grateful they are to have that option given their age and health condition. I know many of our homebound parishioners feel the same way. May God bless and keep safe all our elderly and sick, and those who care for them, and all our many doctors, nurses, and health care workers in the parish who are doing God's work in caring for the most ill in our community.

### THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM



"Baptism not only purifies from all sins, but also makes the neophyte 'a new creature,' an adopted son of God, who has become a 'partaker of the divine nature,' member of Christ and co-heir with him, and a temple of the Holy Spirit. The Most Holy Trinity gives the baptized sanctifying grace, the grace of justification:

- enabling them to believe in God, to hope in him and to love him through the theological virtues;
- giving them the power to live and act under the prompting of the Holy Spirit through the gifts of the Holy Spirit;
- allowing them to grow in goodness through the moral virtues. Thus
  the whole organism of the Christian's supernatural life has its roots in
  Baptism."

# Why are infants given a white bib at their baptism?

When an adult is baptized, there is a part in the ceremony when the newly baptized is vested in a white garment. It is symbolic of the changes that baptism brings in the life of the baptized as they are freed from the bonds of sin and brought into the saving grace of Christ. Realities that are so profound are symbolically presented so that we might better grasp and understand them.

Infants are often dressed in a baptismal dress, which is the baptismal garment. In some places, the bib is used as a kind of baptismal garment. At the place in the ceremony where the investiture takes place, the bib is used. Some are poncholike and fit over the baby's head. Others are simply placed on the baby's chest. If the baby is dressed in a white garment, nothing else is needed. The prayer says it all: "See in your white garment the outward sign of your Christian dignity ... bring that dignity unstained into the everlasting life of heaven."

In baptism, we are given our purpose and goal in life as believers and this is symbolized by the white garment.




# TEXAS RALLY FOR LIFE JAN. 22, 2022




