

I was very pleased to hear from James Bristol, our pro-life director, that he had a tremendous amount of supplies donated toward the local pregnancy center. He said that he emptied the collection bins in the Narthex 3 times!!!

We also collected enough supplies for the Boulder Fire victims that we filled a 14-foot U-Haul truck!! See the pictures included with this column. We also were able to send \$1,757.37 to the Archdiocese of Denver to assist those families who lost everything in the fire.

Finally, thank you so very much for also donating to the victims of the tornadoes in the south. We were able to send \$1,639.70 to the USCCB to assist those who suffered so much during the tornado outbreak.

I am always amazed at the generosity our parish shows toward others who suffer. Even when things occur almost simultaneously as the fires and tornadoes did, our parish still responds generously. Thank you for all you each do.
