Please remember NO glass containers (we've had problems with breakage) and NO REFRIGERATED items. Thank you.

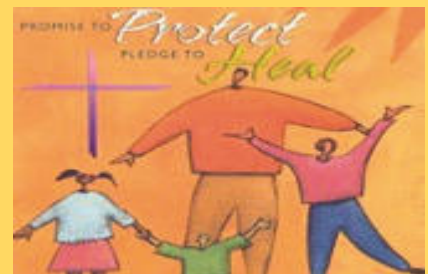
