# JANUARY 30, 2022 4TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

My Dear Parish Family,

This past weekend was the start of something wonderful! This past weekend over 50 of your fellow parishioners and staff members met with an interviewer, Ms. Linda Banecker, from Catholic Leadership Institute.

They were asked to reflect on these questions and to share any other thoughts they had about our Parish moving forward into the future: What draws you to being part of this parish? In your role or ministry, what is the biggest leadership challenge you face? What is one problem, which if you solved it, would take the parish to a whole new level of effectiveness? Then, driven by actual data, de-mographics and your input, we will commit to a three-year strategic plan for our Parish and her ministries. 
